We congratulate Alan Tambosso of Sussex Avenue, who submitted the correct solution. Alan said he just did the crossword in an idle

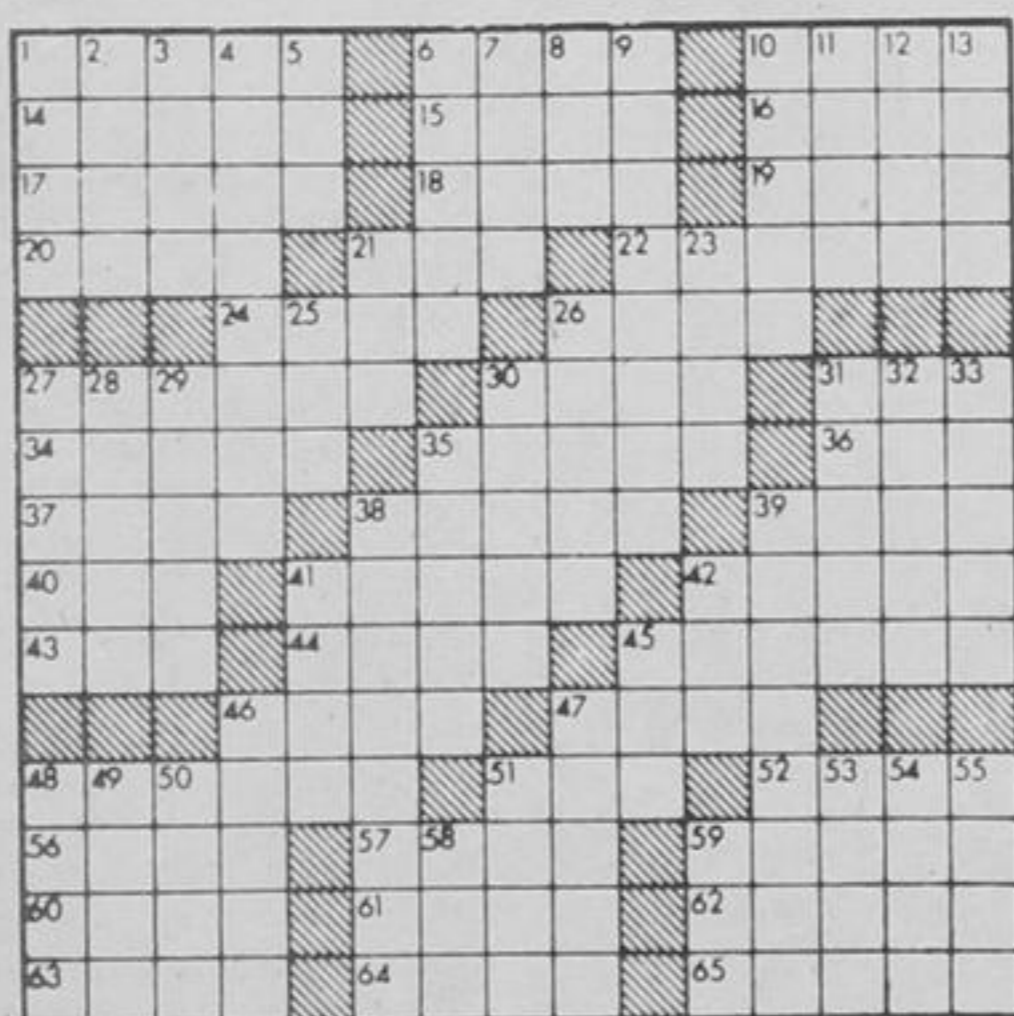
moment and was not an avid crossword fan. He will receive his cheque for \$5.

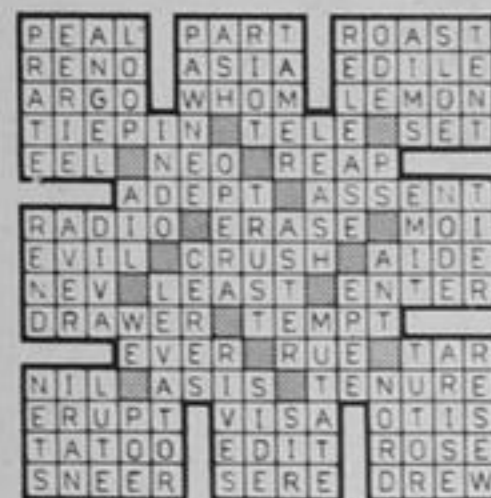

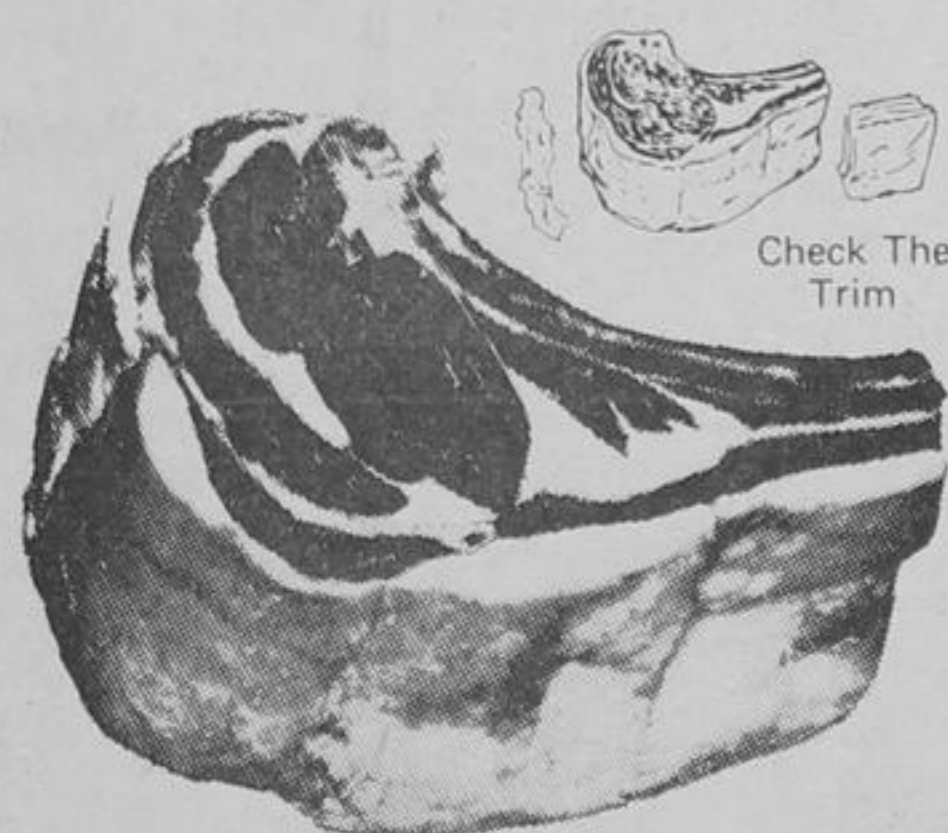

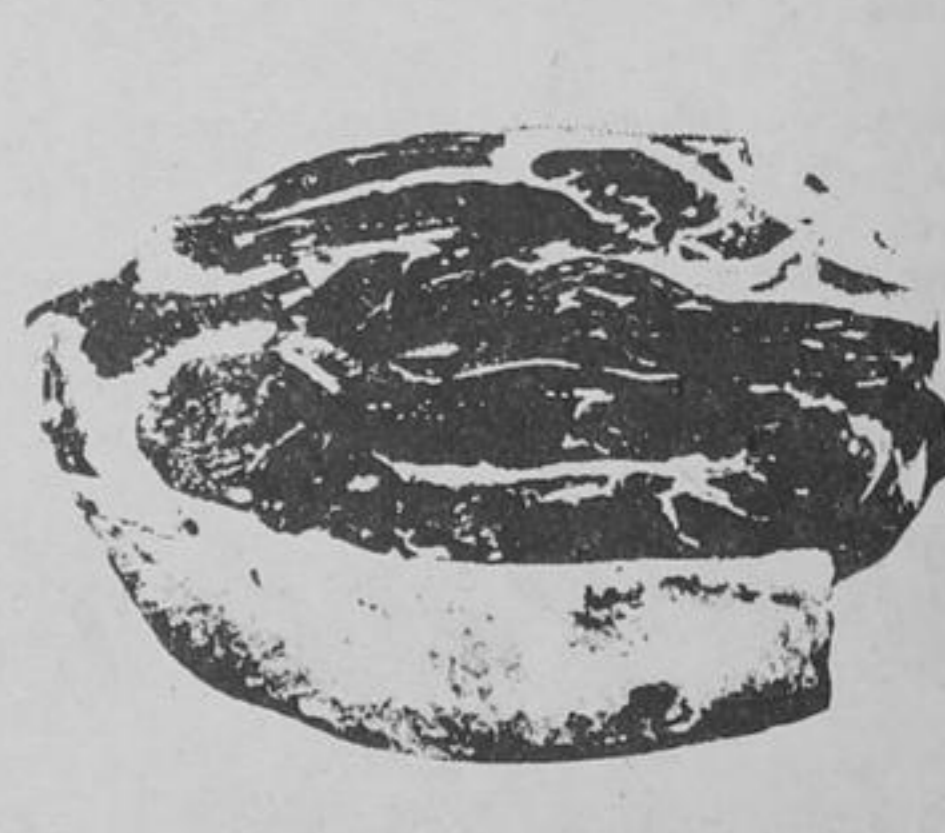
