

## Carpenters oust Bradford in two

# No-hitter for Howard DeGeer

Young Harold DeGeer spun a no hitter against Bradford Thursday night of last week as his Richmond Hill United Brotherhood of Carpenters bantams reached the finals of the South division of the York Simcoe Softball League with two shutout victories.

The Carpenters won 3-0 at Crosby Park Sept. 3 and then dumped Bradford by 4-0 the next night, courtesy of Mr. DeGeer.

DeGeer struck out 18 batters as he tossed a no hitter. He was superb on the mound as only three Bradford batters hit the ball to the infield; every other batter struck out.

This was DeGeer's 18th win of the season as he hit three batters and walked two with no runner going beyond second base.

The Carpenters scored twice in the second as Bill Dickinson singled and Ted Inch walked. Dickinson scored on a

passed ball while Inch came home on Matt Zurich's single.

After two outs in the

fifth, Greg Walton walked and eventually scored on a passed ball. The Carpenters scored again in

the top of the seventh as DeGeer singled and scored on Walton's sacrifice fly.

At Crosby Park the teams were locked in a scoreless tie for five innings before the Carpenters finally scored.

Pete Tipold drew a walk, followed by Bill Dickinson's solid single.

Phil Wood stroked a single to score Tipold, and Greg Walton hit a sacrifice fly to score Dickinson.

Randy Spensley then singled to score Wood. Phil Wood won his

seventh ball game as he scattered six hits while striking out nine batters.

Catcher Spensley gunned down two would-be stealers to help the cause.

Wood was in complete control of the game but had to wait six innings for the Carpenters to score.
