WHEREAS the matters herein set out are in conformity with the Richmond Hill Official Plan which is approved and in force at this

BY-LAW NO. 110-75 EXPLANATORY

NOTE By-law 66-71 provides that in the case of a corner lot no fence or hedge which exceeds 3 feet in height shall be located in the triangular area bounded by the street lines and a line joining the point on each street line distant 50 feet from the intersection of the street line.

The purpose of By-law 110-75 is to reduce the size of the sight triangle by providing that the points on the street lines will be 30 feet from the intersection of the street lines. It also states that a 1 foot reserve abutting a street line shall be deemed to be a street line for the purposes of this


