A note giving an explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law and stating the lands affected thereby is also furnished below.

**ANY PERSONS INTERESTED** MAY, within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill notice of his objection to approval of the said by-law, together with a statement of the grounds of such objection.

**ANY PERSONS** wishing to support the application for approval of the by-law may within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill notice of his support of approval of the said by-law, together with a request for a hearing and a statement of the grounds of such support.

**THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD** may approve of the said by-law but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent.

**THE LAST DAY FOR** filing objections will be the 5th day of January, 1976.

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL**  
BY-LAW NO. 87.75  
A by-law to amend By-law No. 98 of the Corporation of the Township of King

**WHEREAS** the lands affected by this By-law were situated in the Township of King and were annexed to the Town of Richmond Hill by the Regional Municipality of York Act, 1970, but remain subject to the provisions of By-law No. 98 of the former Township of King.

**AND WHEREAS** the matters herein set out are in conformity with the Richmond Hill Official Plan which is approved and in force at this time.

**NOW THEREFORE** the COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law No. 98 as amended by and is hereby amended by:

(a) Adding the following sentence to paragraph f of Section 2: "Insofar as it affects lands situate in the Town of Richmond Hill a STREET OR HIGHWAY means a road assumed by the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill or the Regional Municipality of York or the Province of Ontario or a road allowance upon which a road is being constructed under an agreement with the Town of Richmond Hill."

(b) Adding the following paragraph as Section 6a: "No building shall be erected upon any lands situate in the Town of Richmond Hill unless it is upon a lot fronting upon a highway. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section a dwelling or accessory building thereto lawfully existing on the date of passing of By-law 87.75 of the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill may be repaired or enlarged if it complies with all other requirements of this By-law."

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**  
The lands affected by this by-law were formerly in the Township of King consisting of Lots 61 to 64 inclusive, 69 and 70 and the westerly halves of Lots 67 and 68 in Concession 1. They remain subject to the provisions of King By-law No. 98.  
By-law No. 98 provides that no building may be erected on a lot unless it fronts on a public street. By-law No. 87.75 adds a clause to the definition of "Public Street" to make it clear that it must have been assumed by the Town of Richmond Hill. Regional Municipality of York or Province of Ontario or being constructed under agreement with the Town of Richmond Hill before it qualifies as a public street. This does not prevent the repair or enlargement of a building that was lawfully existing on the day of the passing of the by-law.

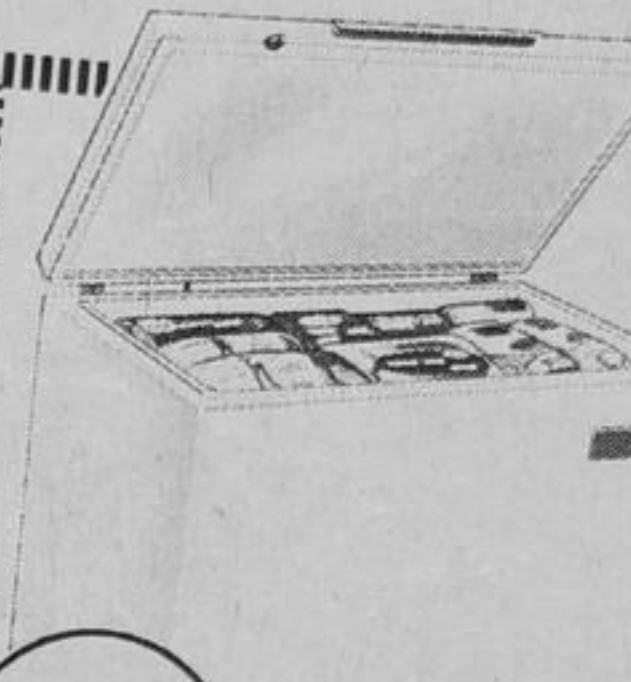

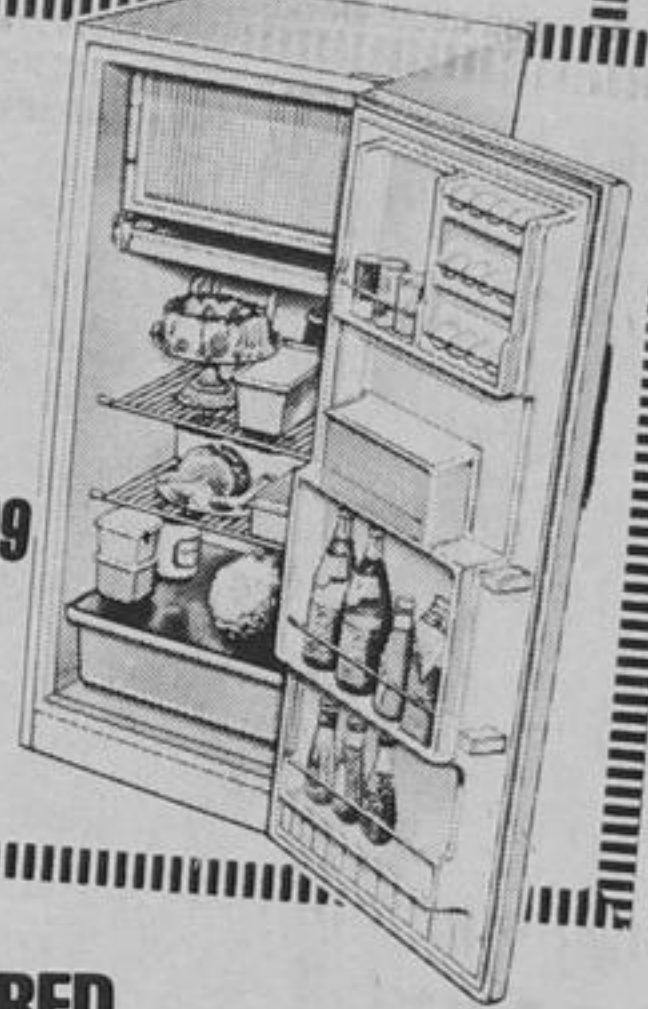

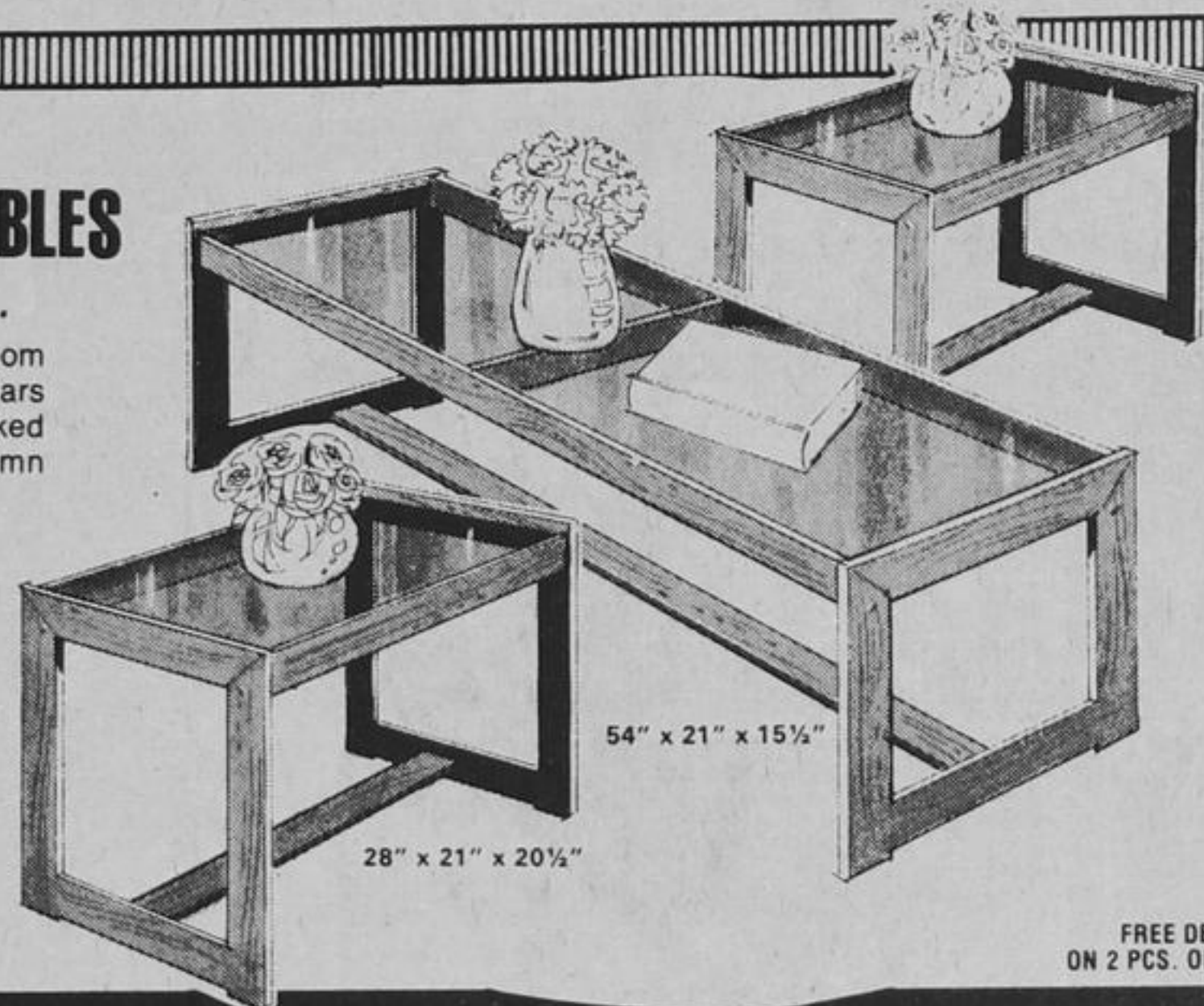
