Should prohibit elevator smoking

Dear editor:

May we please have space to appeal to your readers to express their views on the question of banning smoking in elevators to their members of the Ontario Legislature.

Most people are aware the medical profession and other health agencies including government health departments are concerned over the growing hazard to health caused by second-hand

smoke. This hazard is particularly acute in elevators and among people who have asthma, emphysema and chronic

bronchitis. We feel it is not too much to ask anybody to refrain from smoking in elevators as the ride seldom takes more than a minute but the poisons emitted from cigars, pipes and cigarettes linger on for hours af-

terwards. There is evidence to show asthmatic patients have suffered severe attacks after inhaling

these poisons. The Boroughs of York, East York, Scarborough, York and Etobicoke have all agreed smoking should be banned in elevators.

But they cannot do anything about it unless and until the government of Ontario grants them permission to make the legislation.

A public expression of opinion might help the legislators to make a decision.
