

# 'Twas a week of weird crime

RICHMOND HILL — It was a week of strange happenings in the area, in the realm of both theft and vandalism.

At Twin Hills Mercury, Yonge Street, Richmond Hill, a 1976 Lincoln valued at \$16,000, and owned by a Thornhill woman, was stolen from the lot April 27.

Police subsequently made an arrest. However, while in custody, the accused then damaged his cell.

Charged with break, enter and theft, and mischief, was Steven Russell, 19, of Muskoka. The Yonge Street garage was victimized in another way the same week.

Police said a Holley carburetor was stolen from a new truck, but its loss was not discovered until a salesman tried to

start the truck and it burst into flames.

An estimated \$500 was caused in the blaze, before Richmond Hill Fire Department brought it under control.

**Unusual Thefts**

Four Corners Gulf Station, Concession 7, King Township, reported the theft of \$100 worth of ice cream in a break-in, May 1 or 2.

However, the ice cream wasn't eaten, but instead dumped in a ditch and along the road in Concession 7.

Equally unusual was the theft from the ladies' room at Woodbridge Arena, Highway 7 and Islington Avenue, Woodbridge, where someone walked off with a Kotex machine.

The thief also visited the arena's furnace room and picked up a fire extinguisher.

**Nothing Sacred**

Even the Young and Innocent Shop, Wootenay Road, North, Markham, didn't escape.

A break-in there netted thieves \$75.

Meanwhile in an underground parking lot on Dudley Avenue in Thornhill, someone went on a rampage, breaking 90 light bulbs, several exit lights and various light fixtures, causing \$300 damage.

Vandals also went on a wrecking spree at a house under construction on Yonge Street in Thornhill.

There, walls were smashed, windows and screens broken, and plumbing ripped out, all at a cost of \$1,500.

In a vacant house in Woodbridge on Woodbridge Avenue, vandals started a fire in the fire

place, then used the coals to write on the walls.

They also marked up the floors, causing a total of \$200 damage.

Swimmers, too, found it tough going once out of the pool.

Douglas Prier, Laverock Avenue, Richmond Hill, had his wallet, containing \$25, taken from his pants while swimming at Centennial Pool.

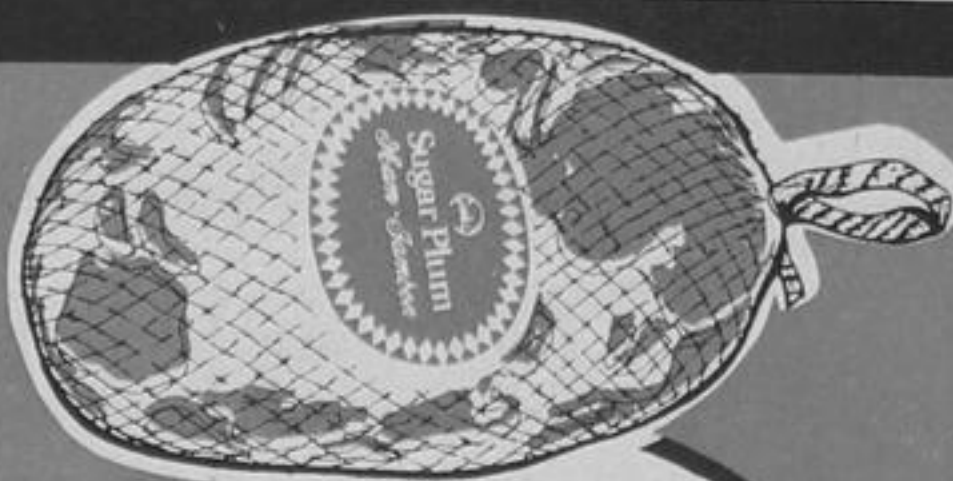

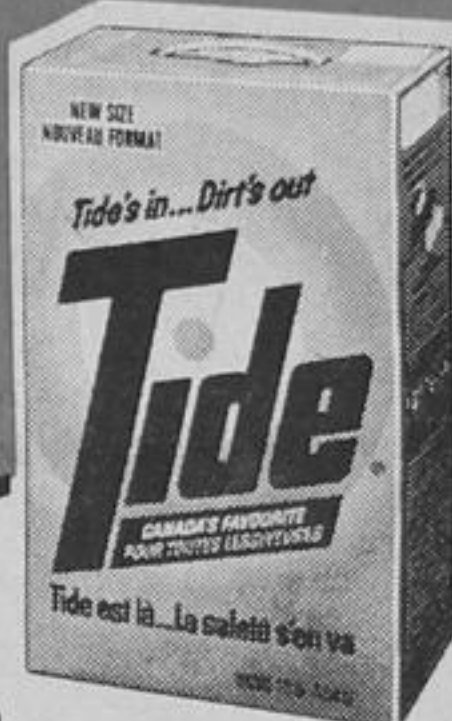
