### NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS TO DESTROY **NOXIOUS WEEDS**



Although Dandelions, Burdock and Goldenrod are not considered noxious weeds within the Town of Vaughan under The Weed Control Act, the cooperation of all citizens is solicited in the elimination. of these nuisance weeds.
