Two arrested after big fight

MARKHAM — Two men have been arrested in connection with a fight that started at one place, ended at another, and resulted in a man being cut in the throat for 20 stitches.

Police said that the early-morning brawl got under way when Peter Lazorau, Agincourt, was confronted in front of the Sherwood Tavern in Markham by two men.

The man then fled and was chased by the victim and his brother, John Lazorau, to Mr. Submarine, where the latter was punched and kicked in the head.

Charged with assault occasioning bodily harm, possession of a dangerous weapon and common assault, was James W. James, 22, of Sherwood Forest Drive, Markham. John S. Hayes, 19, of Robinson St., Markham, was charged with common assault.

An altercation at a residence in Thornhill last week resulted in the wounding of Carol Wilson, 26, of Dudley Avenue.

Police said the woman was involved in an

argument with a man and his 16-year-old daughter, and was punched in the head and body and stabbed in the right hand with a knife.

Police are seeking the woman's common-law husband in connection with the matter.

In Richmond Hill, a man visiting his wife's home and finding everyone gone, took a shotgun and fired a shot into the wall, according to police.

Charged with dangerous use of a firearm was Liberato Ciallelo, 30, of Falstaff Rd., Toronto.

Mt. Albert housing proposals endorsed

NEWMARKET — A proposal to quadruple the size of Mount Albert in East Gwillimbury within the next 15 years, was given an added boost when York regional council approved an amendment to the town's master development plan.

Township planners now need only the approval of Housing Minister John Rhodes to implement the Mount Albert Community Plan.

The plan is opposed by a citizens' group, which fears new housing will have a detrimental effect on the community, with crowded schools, higher taxes and increased crime.

The group wants Rhodes to get the Ontario Municipal Board to look into it.

Township Mayor Gladys Rolling said the

plan was necessary to get a new sewer and water system, road construction, new community services and recreational facilities for the village.

She said that a \$3,500

development levy would be assessed on each new housing unit built under the plan. Present residents of Mount Albert would be charged \$2,500 to connect to the new systems.

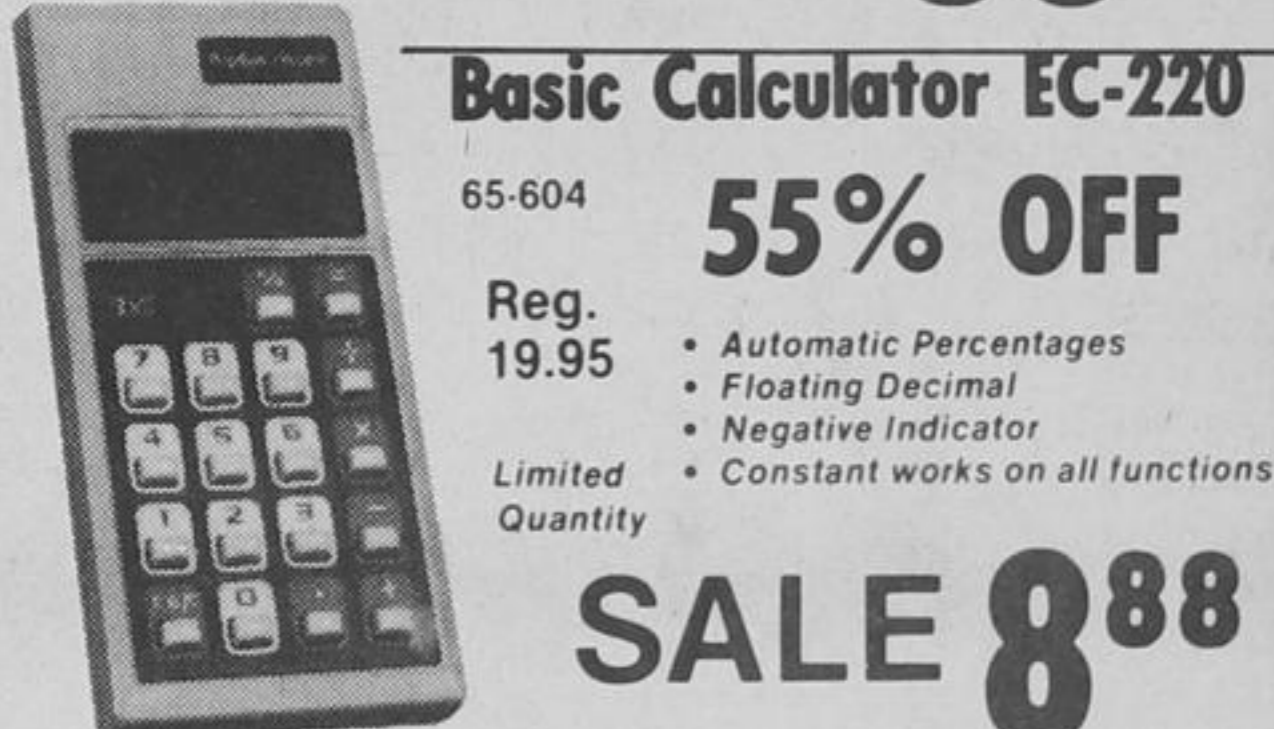

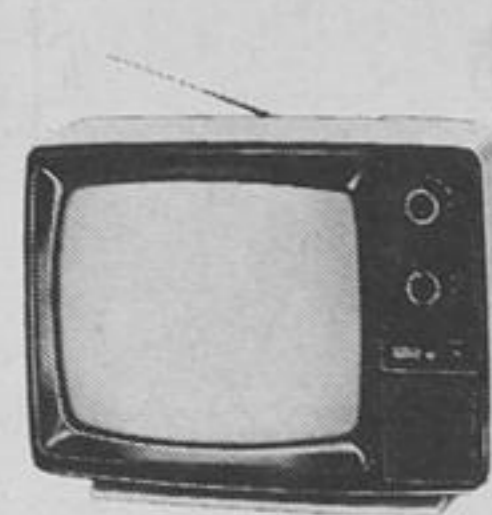

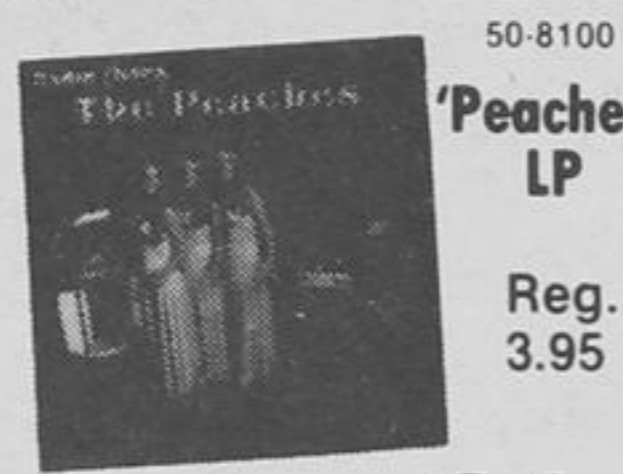
