

More fertilizer for your lawn?

Dear Marion: Should I fertilize my lawn before winter? If so, can I use the same kind of fertilizer I've been using all year? The formula is 10-10-10. Mr. F. L. Thornhill. You should fertilize one last time before winter, but I'd suggest a different lawn food. Get one with a low nitrogen content (the first number.)

Nitrogen encourages the growth of the blade of grass but for the winter, you don't want this.

You want potassium and potash to get a good root system going. Go back to your 10-10-10 in

the spring when you want the grass to green up.

Dear Marion: I have a tree with a broken branch. Actually, one of the larger branches is splitting away from the main trunk. What can I do to prevent the damage

getting worse over the winter?

Mrs. K. H. Richmond Hill. Yes, this definitely needs attending to before winter. Otherwise, the break will not only get worse, but the tree will be susceptible to insects and disease in the wound. Purchase some tree-wound compound and apply to the whole exposed area generously. Make sure no raw wood is left exposed.

Then, using a piece of fabric (I find this best) or some other flexible material, loop around the branch and the trunk.

The "bandage" should end up roughly in the shape of a figure eight around the trunk and branch.

Tie it tightly enough to pull the branch in to the trunk, the way it was before the breakage occurred. Leave it this way till spring, or longer, depending on when the

branch seems firm enough not to break away again.
