

### 3 charged in theft of radios

RICHMOND HILL — York Regional Police have made three arrests in connection with the Oct. 2 break-in and theft of a large quantity of citizen band radios from Mr. C.B., Esna Park Road, Markham.

Police said 10 of the radios, valued at more than \$1,700, had been sold to one man for \$600.

Charged with possession over \$200 was Jack Monahan, 43, of Leith Hill Road in Willowdale.

Charged with break, enter and theft were Randy McMillan, 18, of Markwood Motel, Markham; and Steve Blacktopp, 16, of Fred Varley Road, Unionville.

In Richmond Hill, police arrested three youths in connection with a break-in and theft at Brown's Television and Appliances, 10178 Yonge St.

Taken were two hi-fi sets and a portable TV, valued at \$1,098. The property was recovered at the home of one of the youths.

The three face charges of break, enter and theft, possession over \$200 and breach of probation, among them.

Police have also made an arrest in connection with a theft at the home of Joan Costello, Concession 11, King, when 14 cedar trees were cut down and removed from her property.

Police said the trees had been used as posts and in the construction of a barn.

Charged with theft and possession over \$200 was Patrick MacDonald, 43, of Concession 11, King.

Police made another quick arrest following a robbery at the home of Patricia McDonald, Birch Avenue, Richmond Hill, October 13. However, the property is still at large.

Two juveniles arrested in the theft of \$561 in money and various articles, said they hid the property in a field, but when they went to get it the next day it was gone.

In Woodbridge, police were given a car license number by a woman, who was relieved of her purse while walking east on Highway 7, about 10:50 p.m., Oct. 12.

Sharon Harris of Woodbridge, told police a man ran off to a car after he had robbed her.

She said she flagged down a car and managed to get the number of the thief's vehicle.

### Wounded by own bullet

RICHMOND HILL — A bit of sleight-of-hand put William Anis, 34, of Weston, in York Central Hospital for treatment of a gunshot last week.

Anis told police that, while walking from a house in Gormley to his car, a .22 calibre bullet he had been playing with, dropped from his hand. It then discharged and struck him in the index finger.

Police are investigating the apparently accidental shooting.
