TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 35 of The Planning Act for approval of By-law No. 177-76 passed on the 4th day of October, 1976. A copy of the by-law is furnished herewith. A note giving an explanation of the purpose and effect of the by-law and stating the lands affected thereby is also fur-

ANY PERSONS INTERESTED MAY, within fourteen (14) days after date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill notice of his objection to approval of the said bylaw, together with a statement of the grounds of such objection.

ANY PERSONS wishing to support the application for approval of the by-law may within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill notice of his support of approval of the said by law together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve of the said by-law but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent.

THE LAST DAY FOR FILING OBJECTIONS WILL BE THE 24TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1976.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL

A By-law to Amend By-law No. 3-74 as amended of the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill.

BY-LAW NO. 177-76

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill, pursuant to Section 35a of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1970,

 By-law No. 3-74 as amended is hereby amended by adding to Section 5, General Provisions, the following subsection. 5.28 DEVELOPMENT CONTROL

5.28.1 The provisions of Section 35a of The Planning Act R.S.O. 1970. Chapter 349 as amended apply to the lands shown on Schedule "A". Council may, as a condition of development or redevelopment of land or buildings within such areas, prohibit or require the provision, maintenance and use of the following facilities and matters or any of them and may regulate the maintenance

and use of such facilities and matters: (a) Widenings of highways that abut on the land that is being developed or redeveloped.

(b) Subject to The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, facilities to provide access to and from the land such as access ramps and curbings including the number, location and size of such facilities and the direction of traffic

(c) Off-street vehicular parking and loading areas and access driveways including the surfacing of such areas and drive-

(d) Walkways and all other means of pedestrian access.

(e) Removal of snow from access ramps, driveways, parking areas and walkways.

(f) Grading or change in elevation or contour of the land and the disposal of storm, surface and waste water from the land and

from the land and from any buildings or structures thereon. (g) Conveyance to the municipality, without cost, of easements required for the construction, maintenance or improvement of any existing or newly required watercourses, ditches, land drainage works and sanitary sewerage facilities on the land.

(h) Floodlighting of the land or of any buildings or structures

cover to provide adequate landscaping of the land or protection to adjoining lands. (j) Vaults, central storage and collection areas and other facilities

(i) Walls, fences, hedges, trees, shrubs or other suitable ground-

and enclosures as may be required for the storage of garbage and other waste material.

(k) Plans showing the location of all buildings and structures to be erected on the land and the location.

(I) Drawings and plans showing building elevations and cross sections of industrial and commercial buildings and residential buildings containing twenty-five or more dwelling units.

5.28.2 When any of the facilities and matters listed in the immediately preceding subsection are required by the Council, the Council (a) Require that the facilities and matters be provided and main-

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL

BY-LAW NO. 3-74 **EXPLANATORY NOTE** 

This By law affects the lands in the Town of Richmond Hill known as the Baif Subidivision, Phase II.

The Planning Act was recently amended to permit a municipality to add to a restricted area or zoning by-law a provision which allows it to require a person developing or redeveloping land to enter into an agreement providing road widenings, parking areas, landscaping, etc. las listed in the subject by-law).

By-law 177-76 amends By-law 3-74 by giving the municipality the right to require such an agreement prior to the issuance of a Building Permit.

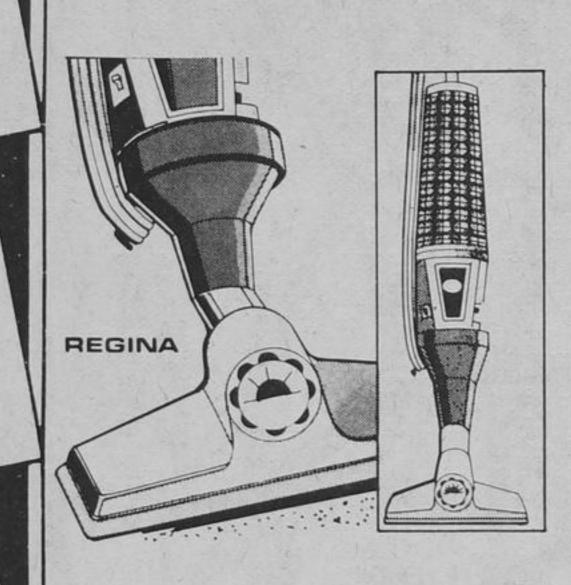

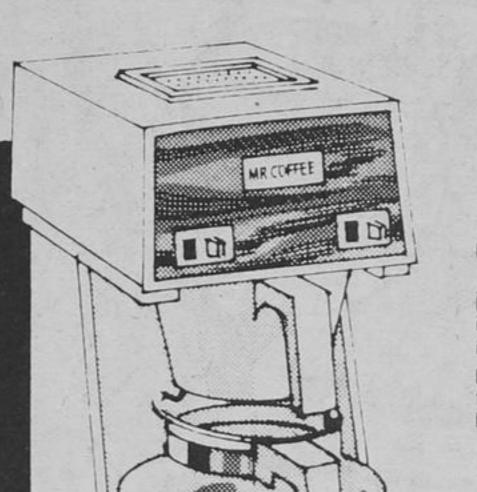

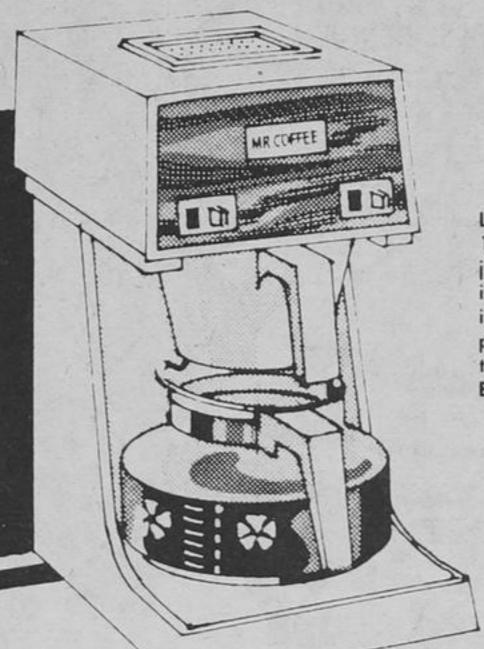
