

Renowned violinist coming

RICHMOND HILL — The Richmond Hill public library system will present a special Christmas concert for "children of all ages" on Dec. 18 at the Charles Connor Memorial Library and the Main Library on Wright Street.

Maurice Solway, a composer, music teacher, actor and one of the world's finest violinists will present a program of folk and classical music from around the world.

Patrons may also enjoy the film, "The Violin," starring Solway, which was nominated for an Academy Award in 1975, and won the Canadian Film and Television Award for the best film score in 1974.

Solway, who studied under the Belgian master Eugene Ysaye, has won international acclaim and high praise from critics. He has served as concert master of the Promenade Symphony Orchestra, Toronto, the San Carlo Opera Company and the Ballet Russe.

R.C.A. has released an album of his work entitled, "Music from the film, The Violin, and folk songs and dances from around the world." The concerts will start at the Charles Connor Branch Library in Oak Ridges at 1 p.m., and at the Main Library Auditorium on Wright Street at 3:30 p.m. The program is sponsored by the Richmond Hill Public Library and the Ontario Arts Council.
