RICHMOND HILL — "Football Daze," the first musical comedy attempted by the students of Richmond Hill High School, will be presented Dec. 16-18 at the school auditorium on Wright Street.

Written and produced by Jean and Bob Thompson, the comedy tells of mythical Roxton Hill High School and the problems when a young woman is inadvertently hired as head football coach.

Difficulties with the assistant coach, the principal, students and school board are all successfully solved by the feminine footballer as she molds a winning team.

The action occurs in the 1948-50 era — which gives the student performers the opportunity to act and talk as their parents might have done.

The love interests in this musical have Coach Gower (Martha Dynes) and her assistant Jim Clark (Mark Attley) finally deciding to work for the best interests of the team and deciding they like it.

Student Josie (Marg Shorten), the first female football player, finally gets together with Flash, the school photographer (John Monk) while Myrtle and Joe, a couple of students, manage to settle their problems before the final curtain.

A cast of 30 will carry the two-act production which includes 14 songs and plenty of chuckles.

Other character parts are Peter Kite as the harassed principal, and Rick Bennett as the football captain.

The 90-minute production begins at 8:30 p.m. and tickets are on sale from RHHS students at \$1.50 adults, \$1 students, and 50 cents for children.

Proceeds will be used for the school to adopt a needy foreign child and for other school programs.

King man killed in accident

RICHMOND HILL — Andrew Black, 28, of Prince Arthur St., King City, was killed Dec. 2 after the car he was driving was in collision with a vehicle driven by Charles Deacon of Willowdale.

The accident occurred on Bathurst north of Mill Street in Richmond Hill. Deacon, his wife Jean, and another passenger, Mary Hutchinson, of Newmarket, were treated at York Central Hospital for injuries.

According to York Regional Police, the accident occurred when the Black vehicle went out of control and crossed the centre line into the path of the other car.
