The dolls that Marg constructs are exact replicas of the antiques, carrying their makers original markings but are now cast in flesh tone porcelain.

The craft is being taught here by resident dollmaker, Marion Fasan, owner of Marion's Doll House on Newkirk Drive.

> The first day of the program is devoted to cleaning the "greenware" or the unfired ceramic pieces. Once scraped smooth, mouths and eyes are cut out and the bisque is fired.

> The second and third day of the program are devoted to china painting of the facial features, followed by another firing, affixing the eyes and finally stringing the arms, legs, body and head together.

> The course costs \$25 and dolls range in price from \$22 to \$75, depending upon the size and the options the dollmaker chooses.

"Some of the people who have made the doll have had no ceramic experience," Mrs. Fasan explained.

"Some say that they're just not talented, or they could never do it, but that's silly. All that is required is patience and care."

estimated at \$300. The doll on the right is a reproduction of the antique Bye-Lo doll and was made as a sample by Marion




