Worst since '75

RICHMOND HILL - Despite Monday's snowstorm, which gave York Region a big head start for a white Christmas this year, police report that traffic conditions were relatively good.

There were numerous minor accidents, but only

one really major one. The bad one, which occurred on Highway 400 at King Sideroad about 8:30 a.m., was enough, however. to close off the highway for the rest of the day.

According to the OPP at Oak Ridges, the accident occurred when a bus slithered off the road and collided with a car at the height of the storm. A series of minor collisions then followed.

Two of the people in the first car suffered minor injuries and were treated at York Central Hospital. Got quieter

The highway was closed off at 9 a.m. Police said that things quietened down considerably after that, with even Yonge St.

(Highway 11) being accident free. Inspector William Smythe of 28 Division of York Regional Police, termed it the worst snowstorm in his memory in 21/2 years.

However, the latter may have even been worse, he said, because it occurred in April, taking even the weatherman by surprise.

Defences double-crossed

double-crossed Richmond Hill's works department. Snow fences in open and rural areas were all set for prevailing westerly and northerly winds where the storms usually come from.

But Monday's big blow came from the east. "We got some drifting we hadn't expected," said Merv Perkins, works maintenance manager.

"But it didn't cause any major problems." Warned early The department had plenty of warning Sunday night and supervisors were cruising the roads to

check conditions at 2 a.m. Monday. They had the crews out at 4 a.m. and easily met their six-hour cleanup schedule. Richmond Hill has 85 miles of roads to plough and 30 miles of sidewalks.

"By 10 a.m. we were into our second routes," said Perkins. The costliest part of snow removal is caused by motorists who leave their cars parked on the street

before the plough comes along, or shovel their


