

# Arkay juveniles split 4 games

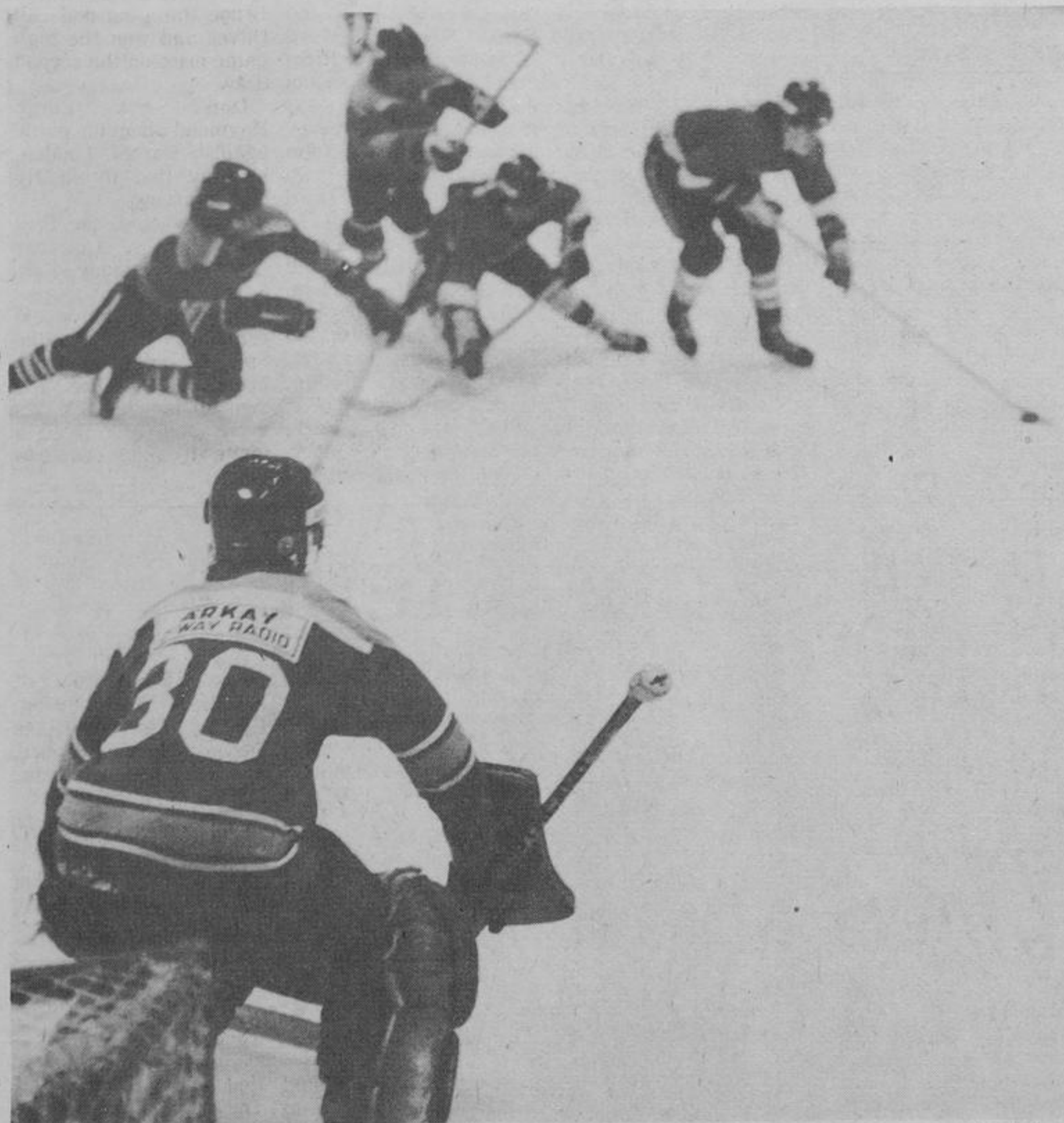
