Moran wants roads instead of parks

BUTTONVILLE — Regional Councillor Ron Moran Thursday called for more money to build roads in Markham in 1977. He wants a cutback in parks and recreation spending.

Moran's comments came during a committee discussion for the proposed \$958 million road budget for 1977. This figure includes \$398,000 in provincial

The largest expenditures will be on John Street. \$360,000 is allocated for the extension of John Street from Don Mills Road to Highway 404.

\$292,000 is for the reconstruction of the street from Porterfield Crescent to the CN overpass.

Land costs Property acquisition for the extension of Highway 7-B from Yonge Street to Eliza Street would cost \$180,000, with no provincial subsidy.

But a bridge on 19th Avenue at Conc. 7 would cost the province \$64,000 and the town only \$16,000. Councillor Tom Grove felt money should be in the budget this year for a feasability study for an overpass at the CN tracks on John Street.

Engineer Dipen Mukherjee said the overpass would not be built for five years. After being pressed, he said it could be built within five years.

But he believed Green Lane could more easily be improved to carry increased traffic when new subdivisions in Thornhill are built.
