## Parkway Hotel busiest ever

RICHMOND HILL — While Metro Toronto hotels may be experiencing a big slump, the Parkway Hotel, Highway 7 and Leslie St., is doing an all-time record business, says Hugh Latimer, hotel superintendent.

Latimer said the hotel's policy of maintaining "very low rates" — singles start at \$19.95 — may have accounted for a portion of the increase. Reported are highs in the number of conventions,

wedding receptions and other gatherings at the hotel. The hotel is also preparing for another business surge when the Don Valley Parkway extension is completed this year.

The new Highway 404 is expected to add an enormous amount of traffic with a cloverleaf beside the hotel doorway.

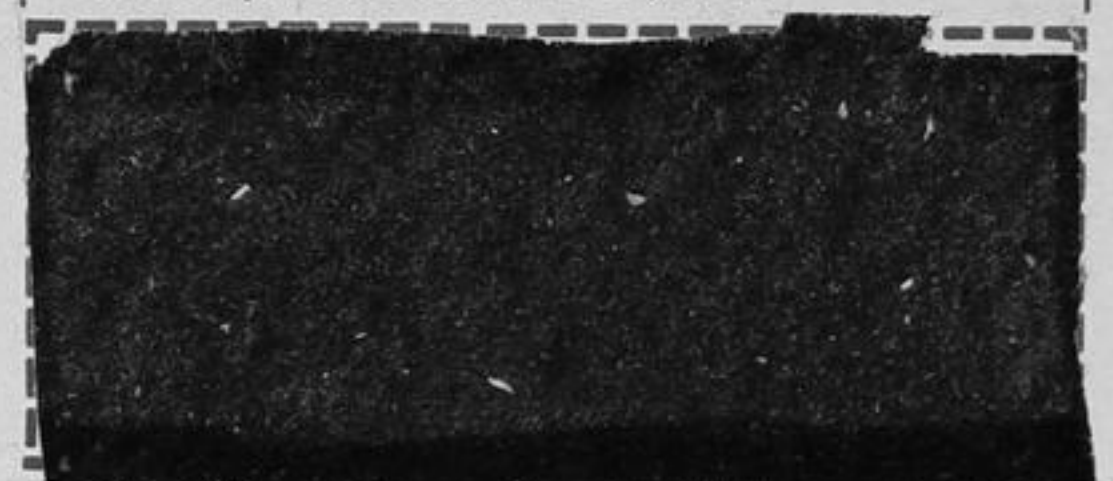
