Marine Park Ferry Ride

Newcastle Island, a marine park in British Columbia, is a 10 minute, 50 cent ferry ride from downtown Nanaimo.

In the fall, the ferry makes the round trip every two hours.

The park's 760 acres of grass, beach and woods are open to pedestrians only. All wheeled vehicles are prohibited.

However, there are moorings buoys and dock facilities for boats.

The park has 18 campsites, two playing fields, a cooking shelter, plenty of picnic tables, washroom facilities, a children's swimming pool, and a change house.

The unspoiled beauty of the island is its greatest attraction.

Broad, well-marked trails lure the visitor deep into the forest of evergreen, arbutus and maple trees, while the beach trail skirts the eastern shore.

The island is also rich in history. In the northern cliffs there are sandstone caves which were used as an Indian burial ground.

Coal was also found here, as well as in adjacent islands, and Newcastle Island was named after Newcastle-on-Tyne in England's coal mining country.

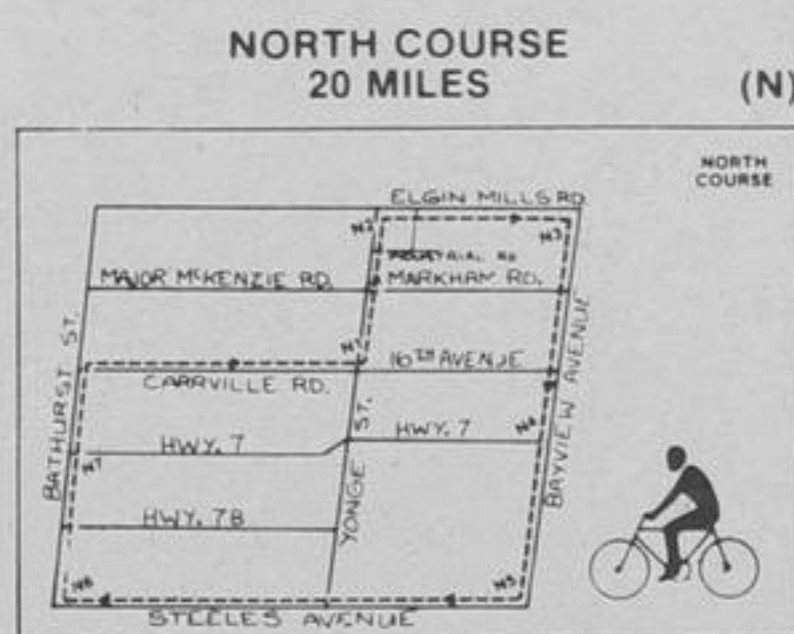

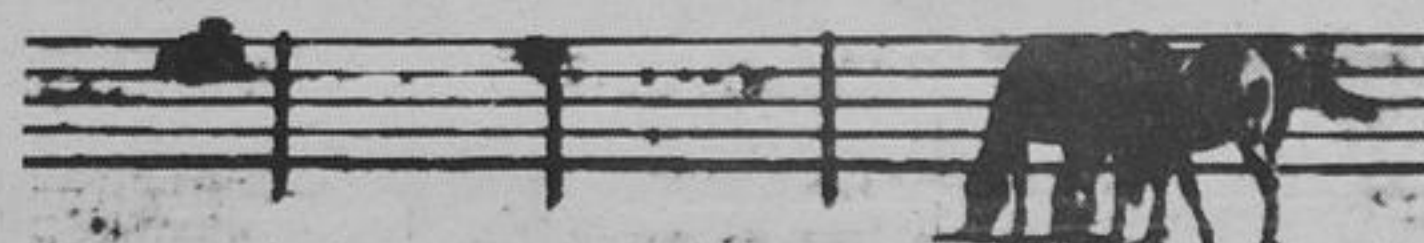
