

Fear of discotheque noise allayed

THORNHILL — Fears of German Mills residents were somewhat allayed last Wednesday evening by representatives from Trizec Equities Limited, developers of Markham Place regarding the proposed discotheque in the mall.

Tom Gilmour, Development Manager of Trizec and Bill Seli, were on hand at the German Mills Homeowners meeting to explain what businesses will be going into the mall, due to open at the corner of Don Mills Road and Steeles in early August.

Mr. Seli said that the restaurant-lounge-discotheque will be patterned after a similar

one now operating in Scarborough Town Center, and would not become a hang-out as many German Mills residents fear.

Recent additions include Samanthas (a gift shop), Capitol Records, Irene Hall (a ladies' fashion store), a snack bar, and on the second level a travel agent, optician and a ladies' and men's hairstyling salon.

The possible annexation of Thornhill was discussed when forms were circulated with the addresses of Premier William Davis, local councillor Tom Gove and Mayor Tony Roman. The ratepayers were asked to send protest letters to Davis with copies to Gove and Roman. Residents also signed a petition opposing the annexation.


In introducing the petition, Patti Grand, President of the German Mills Homeowners Association stressed that you can fight city hall.

She cited a recent case where a resident of German Mills phoned her to complain about the noise coming from a compressor in the Leslie Ravine to the rear of her home.

Mrs. Grand was told by the project manager that nothing could be done about the noise, because Ontario Hydro did not provide enough power, so that the diesel engine had to be turned on periodically causing the disturbance. After phone calls to several people Mrs. Grand finally got action.

She received a call from the Ministry of the Environment informing her that Ontario Hydro will now increase their power, lessening the amount of time the diesel engine would have to be turned on. As Mrs. Grand put it "and that took only four hours of telephone calls".

The ratepayers were informed of the appointments of Andrew Silbiger, former chairman of the Education Committee of the German Mills Homeowners Association, and Stella Todd, former candidate for school trustee, to the Users Committee for JFM public school to be built on Flowervale in German Mills.


