

### Horse rustlers loose

Everything from horses to micro-ovens, were taken by thieves throughout York Region last week.

And in Thornhill, one home was hit twice within a short span.

In the latter case, Sophia Storkus, 63 Thornbank Rd., told police she was working in her front garden. When she came in about 12:15 p.m., she found the rear door open.

The lock had been broken. A check of the house showed her purse was gone.

She said she went across the street to her daughter's house and upon her return, found the back door open again. The house had also been ransacked and \$10 taken.

**Cook-out**  
Cashway Lumber was also visited twice, but not by lumber thieves.

At its Oak Ridges location on Yonge St., the company lost 10 microwave ovens and an automatic garage motor door, valued at \$3,267.

Another Cashway store on Steeles Ave. in Milliken, lost eight of the ovens, valued at \$2,417.

There were also numerous industrial thefts in the area.

In Woodbridge, Nolmar Properties, Geanne Dr., reported the theft of \$1,700 worth of building material from a subdivision under construction on the same street.

Taken were 90 bags of cement, 50 sheets of plywood, 80 sheets of gyproc, plus several other planks of lumber.

Police have the license number of a vehicle believed used in the theft.

At the National Golf Club, Pinevalley Dr., someone drove an electric golf cart through the grounds and then took off with it for a loss of \$2,100.

In Richmond Hill, a window at Sound Unlimited, 10520 Yonge St., plus a quantity of stereo equipment was damaged, when someone was pitched through the window during a fight.

Damage was estimated at \$1,910.

Among the thefts in the Hill: a rear assembly from a 1955 Thunderbird, plus 50 wheels both from Don Reed Motors, Industrial Rd.; two trucks, plus electronic equipment and tools from Classicomm, 244 Newkirk Rd.; Paul Douglas, 165-16th Ave., was relieved of a power mower and cedar picnic table from his backyard.

In Markham, Mr. Transmission, Don Park Rd., reported the theft of \$3,500 in tools and \$300 in cash.

As for those horses — in this case, two of them — they were taken from a fenced enclosure at the home of Jeffrey Miller, 16 Gamble Siderd., Richmond Hill.

They were valued at \$1,800.

**Somedays nothing goes well**  
A suspected thief could have saved himself some time if he had just gone up to the owner's door and approached him about buying back some of his own stolen goods.

According to York Regional Police, a man stole 1½ tons of scrap from the barn of Howard Scott, RR 1, Sharon, May 4.

The next day he took the stolen scrap to Inland Scrap Metals on Ravenshoe Rd. and tried to sell it.

However, Inland's owner recognized the scrap as being the same as that stolen earlier from his barn.

Charged with both theft and possession of stolen goods under \$200, was William Pyke, 37, of RR 1, Sharon.

Colen Rosenberg, 26, of Cedar Valley, Newmarket, suffered superficial chest wounds, after being stabbed in the chest in an attack by two men outside Newmarket Community Centre early Sunday.

He was treated at York County Hospital and then released.
