Other items: Balance of 1975-76 and previous. seasons expenses (Expenses \$5,932.88; Bank Loan, \$3,700; Interest charges, \$770.57) \$10,403.45; Equipment, Crests, Trophies, Repairs, Storage, cleaning, etc., \$6,657.08; referees fees, \$2,074.

Registration brought in the most receipts at \$22,097.50 with admissions into the arena netting \$8,134.55. Sponsors contributed \$16,320; the RHHA Ladies Auxiliary \$10,300; Town of Richmond Hill Grants, \$6,830.92.

The Richmond Hill Lions Club Rosetown Peewee Tournament brought in \$1,183.71. RHHA treasurer William Lazenby was commended by president Reeves for "the

tremendous job he has done since taking over our books this year."




