Another gold winner was Terry Miller in the under 154 pound junior category.

Craig Weldon was a silver for finishing second in the under 127 pound category.

Coach Toule was pleased with the fourth place finish of Alex

Thibault in the under 180 pounds competition.

"He performed extremely well," said Toule. "He's only a green belt but he shows a lot of promise. Another six months to a year and he'll be heard from if he sticks with his training schedule."

Walleye season's open

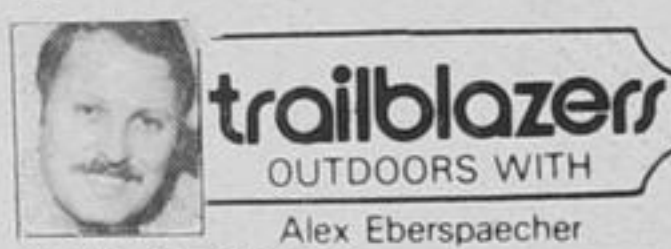
Walleye season has opened in some southern Ontario waters on May 14. Other areas, opening on May 21, are mostly those further north and the Georgian Bay region.

Taken on anything from fancy lures and spinners to live bait, the walleye has puzzled beginner and expert alike. Some days they will hit anything in sight and on others, nothing will entice them to bite.

Being basically a cold-water fish, they seldom do well in small or shallow bodies of water. The eyes are very sensitive to light and colour so fishing should be confined to the darker hours of the day. Night fishing will often bring your limit in short order.

FORGET IT

Forget about still-fishing with a float if you want walleye. Fish on the bottom in moving water with a



Shiners are the most productive minnows you could use. One lure that most of us ignore is the lowly worm harness.

Yellow beads are best and it should be trolled or drifted slowly enough to bump along the bottom.

A few times I got my limit of those superb-eating fish on a worm harness when everything else failed.

POPULAR LURES

The most popular lures are those with a yellow finish such as the Bono and Flatfish. The former is a must in the Rice Lake region.

A great many fish are taken every year in the Moon River area and the

Kawartha region on silver Rapalas, which, again, must be trolled dead slow.

Rosedale, on Balsam Lake will undoubtedly take the main onslaught of anglers this season. Being only 95 miles from this area, a day's outing is quite possible.

To get there, take Highway 35 to Rosedale, turn right after passing over the bridge across the Trent Canal. The road ends right by the dam where you should be fishing. Most fish are taken on Rapalas, with bottom jigs a second choice.

MOON RIVER

The Moon River, about 140 miles from Toronto, also is an excellent fishing spot. Take Highway 69 through MacTier and then take Healy Lake road right down to Woods Bay where it ends.

A boat is a must as I doubt if you

will be able to rent one since this hot-spot is usually booked from the year before. Woods Bay itself is usually very good, as is the area of the Moon River Basin.

You cannot fish below the falls for a short distance as this is still a sanctuary.

Minnows usually take the most fish, with Rapalas during the night getting the larger ones.

CLOSE TO TORONTO

If you wish to remain within 100 miles of Toronto, take a look at the waters of Georgian Bay by the bridge at Port Severn. Fishing right off Highway 69 is possible.

Whatever you and wherever you fish, don't forget to fish deep and troll as slowly as you can.

Walleye are lazy fish and no doubt, you are going to find out that you must work hard for your limit.
