
# ARE YOU\* ELIGIBLE TO VOTE on Thursday, June 9th?

By now you should have a receipt (Form 103-see illustration) - proof that you have been enumerated and therefore are eligible to vote. Take Form 103 with you to the Polling Place when you go to vote at the Advance Poll or on


Election Day. ( June 9th ). Check Now - do YOU have form 103?
