

# Jones strikes again

Bill Jones of Richmond Hill has been a Master Bowler for the last 12 years and he's had many exciting moments including a perfect game in 1962.

But he's excited all over again.

Good reason. Jones, who bowls out of ABC Bowling Alley in Richmond Hill, will be one of only five bowlers representing Ontario in the Master's Teaching category in the Canadian finals in Saskatoon July 1, 2 and 3.

He won his position by finishing third in the Master's 5-pin Teaching bracket with an aggregate average of 276 over the year which was also good enough to place him in 10th place in the

over-all Master's standings.

"I've had a lot of thrills in bowling," Jones said, "but I've never represented the province in a competition like this before."

Jones explained that he stepped down from the Master's division because "it involved a lot of travel to tournaments which takes time and money. And I'd been doing it for a number of years."

"My wife, Evelyn, is also a Master bowler and we travelled to most of the tournaments throughout the years."

Bill is also elated because another member of the ABC Bowling Alley, Craig Rayson of

Willowdale, will be joining the team on the Saskatoon trip as an alternate.

"Craig came within one end of bowling a perfect game," enthused Jones. "He bowled nine perfect frames but he left the corner pin standing in the last one. "Then he came up with two more strikes in the first two frames of the next game," he said. His average was 418.

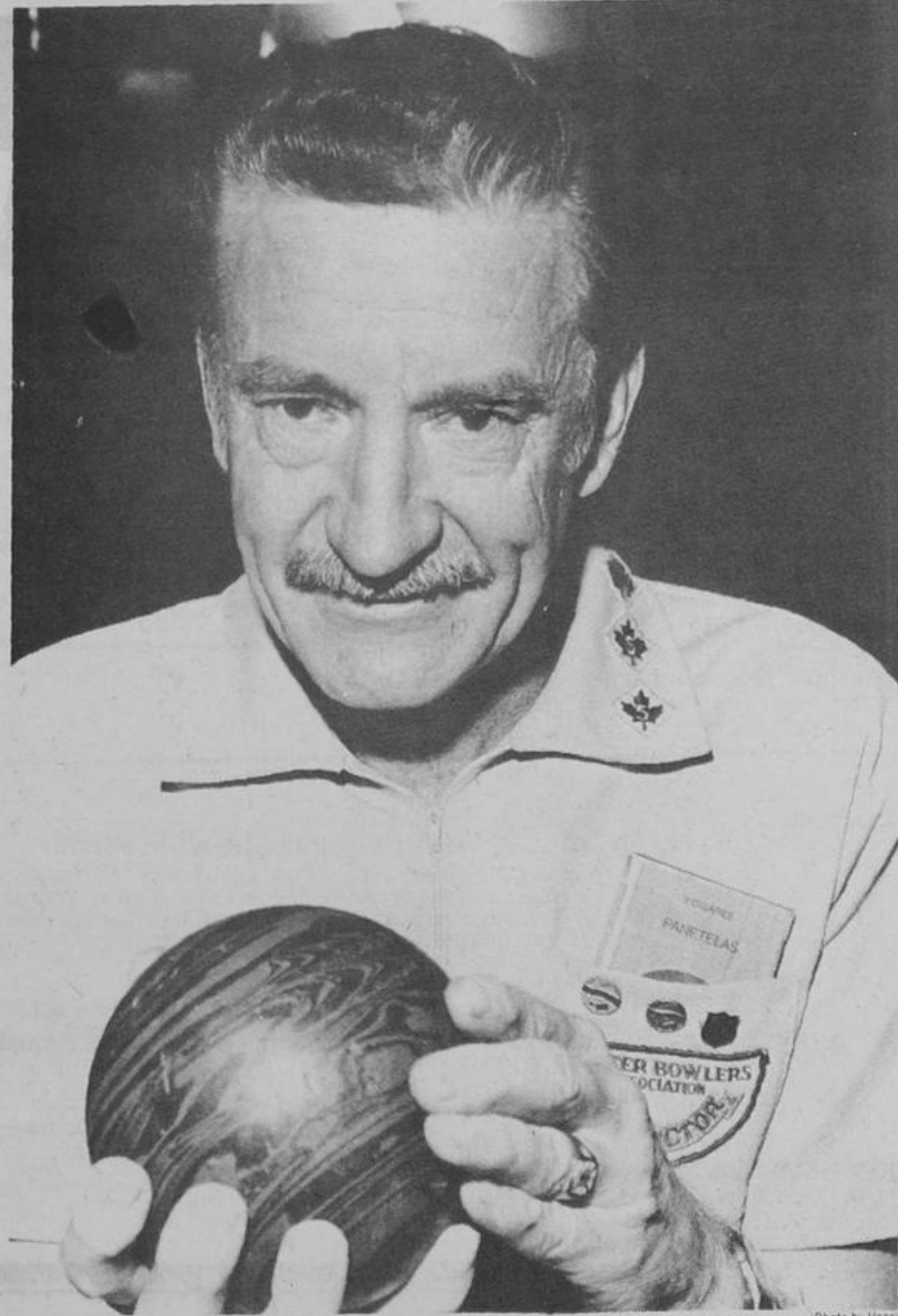
As for Jones, he enjoys being a Master's Teacher because "it involves less tournaments and you don't have to travel as much."

Some of Jones' big moments included the aforementioned perfect game in 1962.

"That's the only perfect game I've thrown," he said. "They don't come that often. Some bowlers have managed it two or three times."

But Jones still gets a gleam in his eye when he talks of that perfect game.

He'd like to do it again. Just one more time.

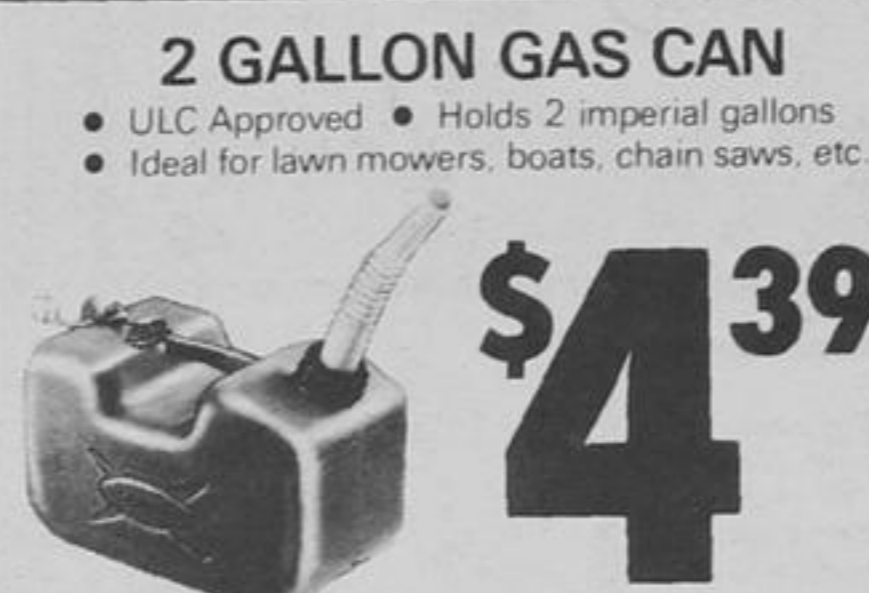

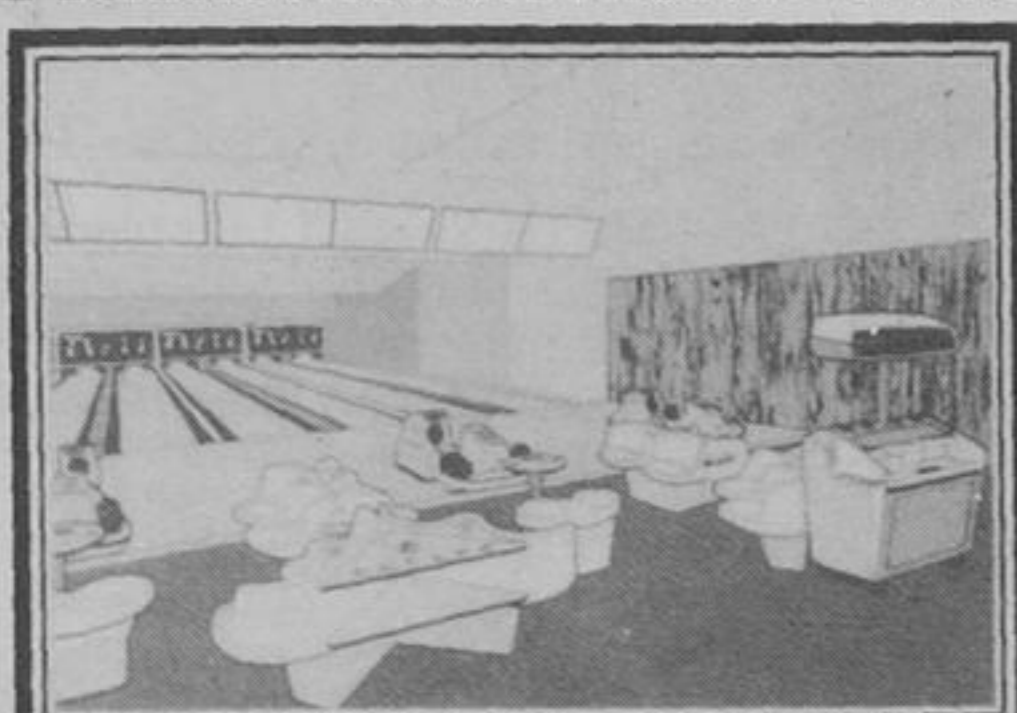

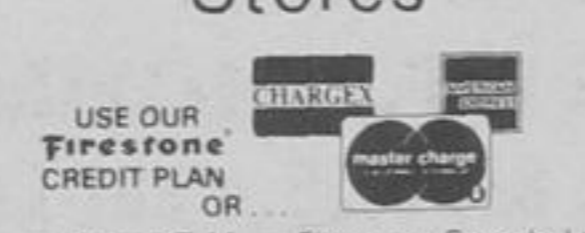
