"Metro assumed the north side of Steeles some time ago," explains York Police Chief Bruce Crawford.


"We couldn't very well police the north side, since it is subject to metropolitan Toronto bylaws," he said.

Into the affairs of Waste Management Inc., Disposal Services Ltd.,

By Order-in-Council dated the 15th day of May, 1977 and pursuant to the provisions of The Public Inquiries Act, 1971, a Commission was issued appointing

to inquire into any wrongdoing or impropriety or any improper influence being brought to bear on members of the Ontario Government, or its Public Service on the part of officials of Waste Management Inc., Disposal Services Ltd., and affiliated Companies, or of any other individual or individuals, in respect of applications for land fill sites by the said Companies or affiliates, or any agency thereof, since 1971, to the Ministry of the Environment or the Department of the Environment or the Department of Energy and Resources Management and to report thereon and to make such recommendations to the Lieutenant Governor in Council as he may deem fit.
