ROYAL COMMISSION OF INQUIRY

Into the affairs of Waste Management Inc., Disposal Services Ltd., et al.

By Order-in-Council dated the 15th day of May, 1977 and pursuant to the provisions of The Public Inquiries Act, 1971, a Commission was issued appointing

The Hon. Mr. Justice S.H.S. Hughes

to inquire into any wrongdoing or impropriety or any improper influence being brought to bear on members of the Ontario Government, or its Public Service on the part of officials of Waste Management Inc., Disposal Services Ltd., and affiliated Companies, or of any other individual or individuals, in respect of applications for land fill sites by the said Companies or affiliates, or any agency thereof, since 1971, to the Ministry of the Environment or the Department of the Environment or the Department of Energy and Resources Management and to report thereon and to make such recommendations to the Lieutenant Governor in Council as he may deem fit.

NOTICE

The Commission will convene an initial hearing in Court Room #20 in the Courthouse, University Avenue, Toronto at 10:00 o'clock in the morning on Friday, the 3rd day of June, 1977 for the purpose of:

1. Dealing with preliminary matters
2. Deciding upon the procedure to be followed.
3. Settling a date for the continuation of the Inquiry having in mind the need of the Commission to complete an investigation which has only just been launched.

Persons or corporations who claim a substantial and direct interest in the subject matter of the Inquiry are asked to attend personally or by Counsel
