A spokesman for the Vaughan Parks and Recreation Department said the idea of "the day is to get the various communities to work together to put on such a program with the Town acting in a supervisory capacity."

Vaughan Director of Recreation Paul Wilson heads the Vaughan Day Advisory Committee.
