## Science scholar

A King City youth, Scott Peterson, recently placed among the top students in a set of voluntary science scholarship exams.

Peterson, a Grade 13 student at King City secondary school, also placed in the top five per cent in Ontario for the University of Waterloo Des Cartes mathematics scholarship.

The exams are held by various universities for interested students.

Peterson's scores: University of Waterloo Sir Isaac Newton physics exam - tied for 24th out of 4,256; University of Toronto Canadian association of physics exam - ninth out of 24; University of Waterloo chemistry exam - tied for 79 out of 5,000 students; York University biology exam - 12 out of 825.

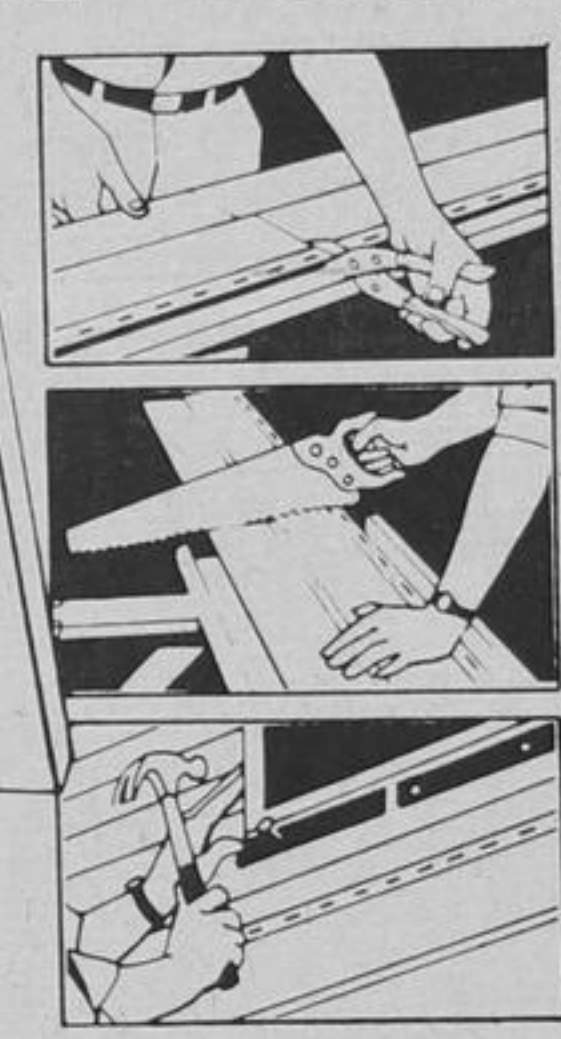

Cutting is done with tin snips or a saw. In cutting with tin snips, strip away insulation, score the siding with a knife along a straight edge and cut in the score line, being careful to get a clean cut where the metal is folded and formed.  
In cutting with a saw, merely line up the siding, mark the cutting point and saw. The use of any ordinary candle or a bar of soap on the blade will greatly reduce burning AND increase blade life.  
For window and door finishing, fur out to the proper distance so the siding lays smooth and even. If it isn't, the furring is too thick or thin and must be adjusted. When it's right, you may want to cover the cut edge with trim for a neatly finished appearance.

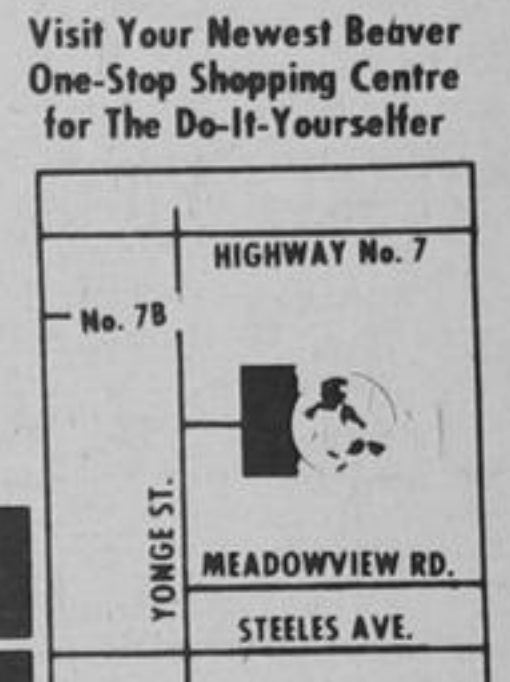
