

Rolling warns of empire building

"Some people would like to take away all municipal governments and have just regional governments. This is empire building, and I don't like it."
 "I'd fight that, believe me. And I don't give up easily."
 In a telephone interview Tuesday morning, Gladys Rolling, former mayor of East Gwillimbury and founding member of York Region council, elaborated on statements made last week to the Georgina Chamber of Commerce.
 She was guest speaker at the chamber's third annual meeting, and spoke about inter-governmental relations.
 At that time, she said some municipalities have made things difficult for regional bodies by incurring deficits, and by blaming regional government for tax

increases.
 "In my humble opinion," she told The Liberal, "I don't think regional government is the cause of all our problems."
 "In all honesty, mistakes are often made by municipalities."
 She said York Region was formed "almost word for word" as suggested in Bill 102. "We got regional government on our own terms."
 "Since that time I've had a few changes of heart," she admitted. "Hindsight is better than foresight."
 "I do believe in two-tier planning, but you should leave as many things as possible at the local level."
 "I would think the future of municipal government is assured — the immediate future, in any case."
 But "the time is long since gone when a municipality could think of itself as an island," she said. She did concede there were times when delays cost

money, and suggested that making developers responsible for water supply and sewage treatment facilities (now in the regional purview) could result in reduced costs.
 "With their own companies, they (the developers) could do it cheaper," she said.
 "In my opinion — and a lot of people disagree with me — I think regional government has a lot of good points. It could work if we started thinking regionally instead of locally."
 Regarding provincial government, Mrs. Rolling was quoted as telling the chamber that, if municipalities stood together, "no one on earth can ignore you".
 She said nothing irritates her more than bureaucrats at Queen's Park who, she charged, hold things up.
