PROPOSED OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT - SOUTH EAST MARKHAM

A Public Hearing will be held by the Planning Committee of the Council of the Town of Markham to consider an amendment to the Official Plan, the purpose of which is to redesignate parts of Lots 8 and 9, Concession 8 (South East Markham) from Rural to predominantly Low Density Residential and associated community uses. The Low Density Residential designation may consist of single family detached dwellings, semi-detached dwellings and single attached dwellings such as street townhouses or linkhouses; however, the present proposal for the area contains only single detached dwellings and semi-detached dwellings.

Development will require approval of plan(s) of subdivision which will have to conform to a basic pattern of internal streets, location of schools, parks and other associated community facilities which are proposed to be established by the amendment.

You are invited to attend the Hearing and to state your support of or objection to the proposed amendment. Should you be unable to attend, written submissions will be received up to the time of the Hearing.
