scheduling of the tournament three times, before it was completed. Some of the most hard-fought matches included: Cara Sheppard over Paula Wileman, 7-6, 6-7, 6-4, and Tim Flanagan over

Jonathon Angel in the boys' under-14 category. All four players are from the Richmond Hill club.

Hill, lost to Rory Hunter of Markham, 6-4, 5-7, 7-5. Richmond Hill players dominate the junior regional team, which was selected last week in Newmarket for the

Ontario regional junior championships in Collingwood, Aug. 22-27. Those selected: under 18 - Sandra MacMillan, Richmond Hill; Linda Sills, Thornhill.

Under 14 - Cara Sheppard and Diana Girdler, both of Richmond Hill. Other Richmond Hill juniors who qualified for the final rounds are: Mark Girdler, Richard

Vermeulen, Scott Smith, Peter Bedard, Jennifer Sheppard and Diana Girdler. In the York-Simcoe ladies' doubles championship this week at Aurora tennis club, an all-Richmond Hill final saw Jean Scott and Carol Coady beat Joy August and Monica Vermeulen in a tough three-setter.

Three tennis titles upcoming

It's tournament time in the tennis world, with two closed and one open championship in the offing. The latter category will see the Ontario Open championships at Tennis Centre, York University, July 11 to 17. The two closed competitions will cover both the doubles and the singles in the junior field.

The doubles will be held at North York tennis club, Hollywood Park, Willowdale, July 15 to 17. The singles' final will be played at Kew Gardens tennis club, 77 Kew Beach Ave., Toronto, July 18-23. In both events, there will be categories for under 18, under 16, under 14 and under 12. More than 2,000 boys

and girls compete in the singles' event annually. Former winners include Canadian international players, Dale Power, Jim Boyce and Lise Senn. Nicknamed "The Tournament that Almost Wasn't," because of a last-minute withdrawal by the host St. Catharines tennis club, the Ontario Open has lined up what

promises to be a highly-competitive and entertaining main draw. Defending her women's singles crown is Kym Ruddell, ranked 17th in Australia. She faces stiff competition from Lisa Rap Sam, Jamaica's top female player and Federation Cup team member. Among the Canadian

contingent are Susan Pridham of Oakville, ranked sixth nationally, and Pat Sinclair of Toronto, number 11 nationally. Harry Fritz, winner of the 1977 Canadian professional national indoor and '76 Canadian Grand Prix circuit, will be on hand, as will Leo

Rolle, 10-year veteran of Davis Cup play. Jim Boyce, last year's Canadian National champ, plus third-ranking Dale Power, and Dave Brown, ranked number 10, make up the Toronto contingent. Fritz and Boyce won the doubles' title last year.


