## Rain the winner at pro-am

One player too many showed up at the annual Shrine Pro-Am golf tournament last Friday at Rolling Hills, Richmond Hill and Huntington clubs. Rain.

Pelting hail and rain washed away the third round of the \$70,000 tournament and with it \$3,900 of George Knudson's money.

During Friday's deluge, tournament organizers shortened the 54-hole tournament to three tournaments of 36 holes.

Knudson, who was 10 under par and a three-shot leader over Dan Haldorson of Brandon, Man., was two under par through six holes in Friday's round at Rolling Hills while Haldorson was two over at Huntington. Instead of winning

\$5,000 as being top pro and an additional \$1,000 as skipper of the winning team, Knudson earned only \$1,500 in one of the three \$9,000 sections and \$600 as leader of the winning team in his section.

The pro-am tournament was billed as the largest of its kind in the world with professional golfers fighting it out for \$35,000 in cash, while amateurs struggled for an equal amount in prizes.

"Even the Big Crosby pro-am has only \$5,000 worth of merchandise on the table," tournament chairman Ken Foss said.




