## School needs renovating to decrease fire hazard

There is a bit of sweeping up to be done at Richmond Hill High School before students go back to school in September.

It is mainly the interior of the school which is undergoing renovations at the cost of \$215,000 to reduce fire hazard, said Ross Risebrough, supervisor of construction for York County Board of Education.

"The renovations will not make the building completely fire-proof since the old central part of the building is mostly wood," he said. "Tearing out the section and rebuilding would make it safer but the funds are not available to do that."

Five new sets of stairs and stairwells are being

built and some of the old wood ceiling tile is being replaced by a mineral, fire-proof type, he said.

"In case of fire, we want to be sure that people will be able to get out of the building," he said. "There were not enough exits previously as the school was built in pieces over the years." A completely new staircase is being built to the east of the library and the south-west flight is being extended to the third floor, said janitor, William Brignell.

Portions of walls have been knocked out so that two fire-proof doors will be installed in all the science rooms and the home-economics room, he said.

"I figure renovations

will probably be completed by December," said Mr. Brignell.

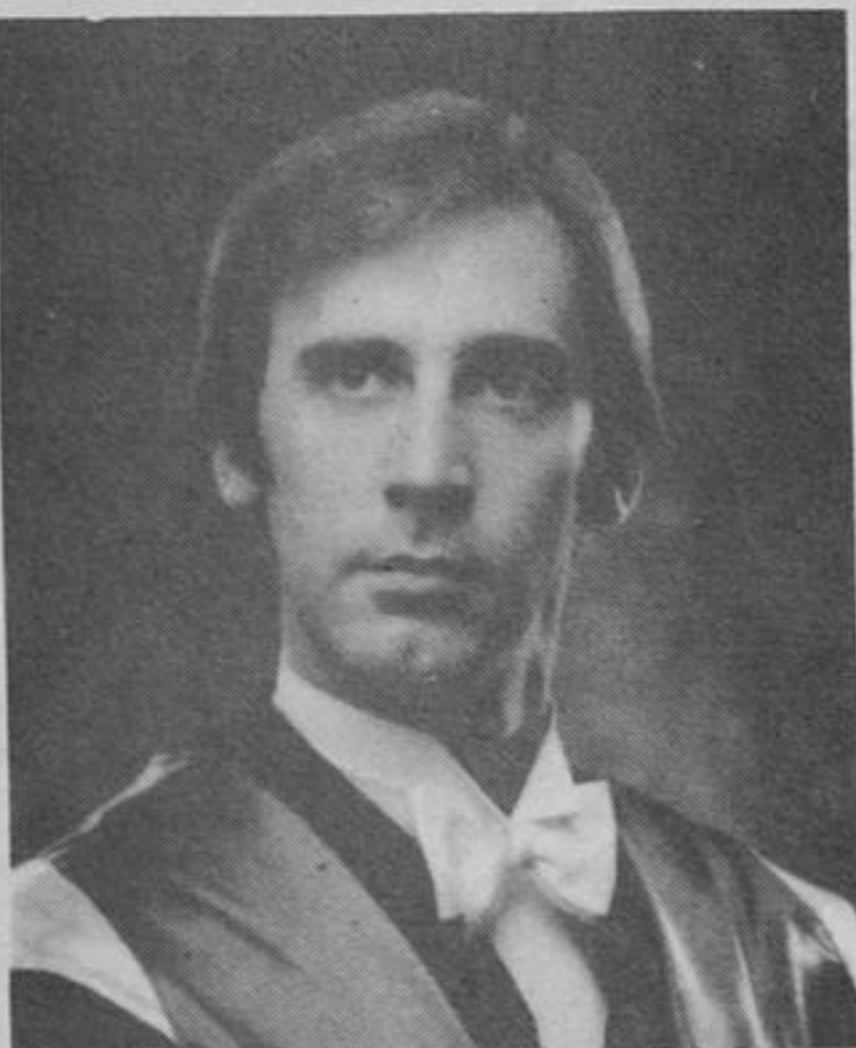
