Bell expands in King City

Bell Canada will spend \$127,500 to expand its switching centre in King City and provide the capacity for an additional 100 telephone directory numbers, local Bell manager Hugh Allan said this week.

A contract has been awarded to Cloke Construction Co. Ltd., of Scarborough to build a one-storey addition measuring 47 feet by 18 feet, to the rear of the building.

Work is expected to be complete by next April. Equipment will then be installed and ready for service by June, Mr. Allan said.

Lorne and Mary Mayes of Lake Avenue will be leaving us to make their home in Calgary. Lorne will be working in surveying.

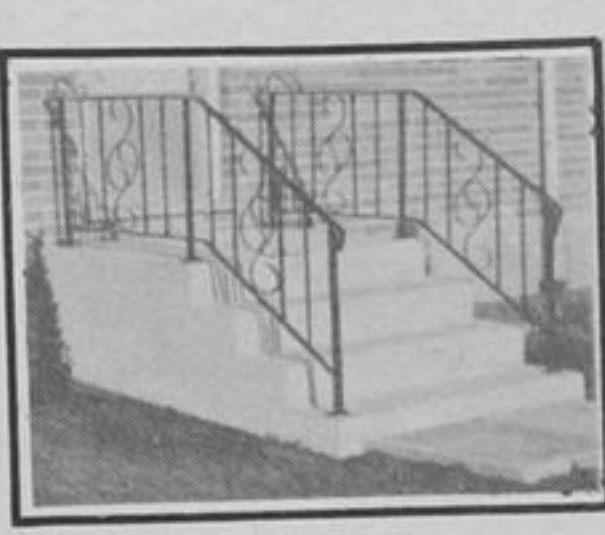
Lorne has been an Oak Ridges resident all his life.
