

Fire occurs adjacent to future fire hall

A fire in an empty barn at Kipling and Woodbridge Aves., in Woodbridge Friday afternoon, was just a few months premature, so far as Vaughan Fire Department was concerned.

The fire, which destroyed the barn, occurred right next to the department's fire hall, which is now under construction.

The building is expected to be completed the end of this year, according to Chief James Davidson.

The barn fire, which was believed to have been started by children, broke out about 2:30 p.m., and was still smouldering an hour later, as fire fighters used ropes and a tank truck to pull the barn to the ground.

The building had been leaning at a perilous angle after the blaze was extinguished.

Light plane forced down in Markham

No one was injured when a light plane was forced to make a landing in a field on the east side of Leslie St., one mile south of Bethesda Rd. in Markham, Aug. 28.

According to York Regional Police the plane, which was returning to Buttonville Airport from Parry Sound, about 8:30 p.m., was forced to set down when the pilot, Thomas Heinz of RR 1, Unionville, noticed it was low on gas.

He notified air traffic control at the airport and put down in the field.

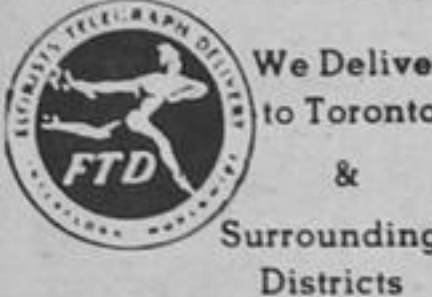
