
Proceeds will go to the new Markham Pool Complex, the cystic fibrosis fund and other service projects in the Markham area.

The latter would then presumably be the one who broke into the home of Steven Dikschel, 8520 Pine Valley Dr., Woodbridge, Sept. 1.


Taken were a quantity of Canadian stamps, 10 bottles of Holland perfume and some jewelry. Two other places in the community were also visited by thieves.


