Speeding ticket justified, police commission agrees

A York Regional Police officer was justified in giving a Peterborough woman a speeding ticket, despite her claims that he lied when he served the summons, the regional police commission ruled last week.

A report from Police Chief Bruce Crawford stated that Beverley Shier had been convicted in court and fined, and that the officer acted properly in the case.

Miss Shier first wrote to police commissioner Ray Twinney about how she was treated after being stopped on the 9th Line North in Stouffville last March 22.

She subsequently sent a letter to the police commission complaining about the incident.

Her letter said, in part, that Constable Willis Postill "prevaricated to both my witness and I about (a) my having driven over 30 m.p.h., and (b) his following us for three miles."

She felt it was not necessary for him to "rudely accost me verbally," and charged that he "acted in a most perjorative fashion when

I quietly brought to his attention the fact that he had strayed from the truth."

In his report, Chief Crawford stated that Miss Shier had been subsequently found guilty as charged and fined \$27.

In a statement to the chief, Constable Postill insisted he had been "more than polite, and was not obusive."

\$3,000 to replace obsolete firearms

York Regional Police will pay more than \$3,000 for 23 new revolvers to replace some obsolete weapons now used by the force.

Police Chief Bruce Crawford told the police commission last week that when the regional force came into being, 25 revolvers inherited from local forces did not meet Ontario Police Commission on standards.

Ten of the substandard weapons have been replaced, but 15 still

He added that in his eight years of service, "I have never encountered a female motorist that was so belligerent and obnoxious before knowing why she was being stopped."

The police commission voted to receive her letter and forward a copy of the chief's report to Miss Shier.

remain in use. Of the 23 weapons to be purchased, 15 will replace the substandard weapons, with seven going to new officers expected to be hired later this year.

One revolver will be kept as a spare. The purchase will be made from J. R. Gaunt and Sons Co.

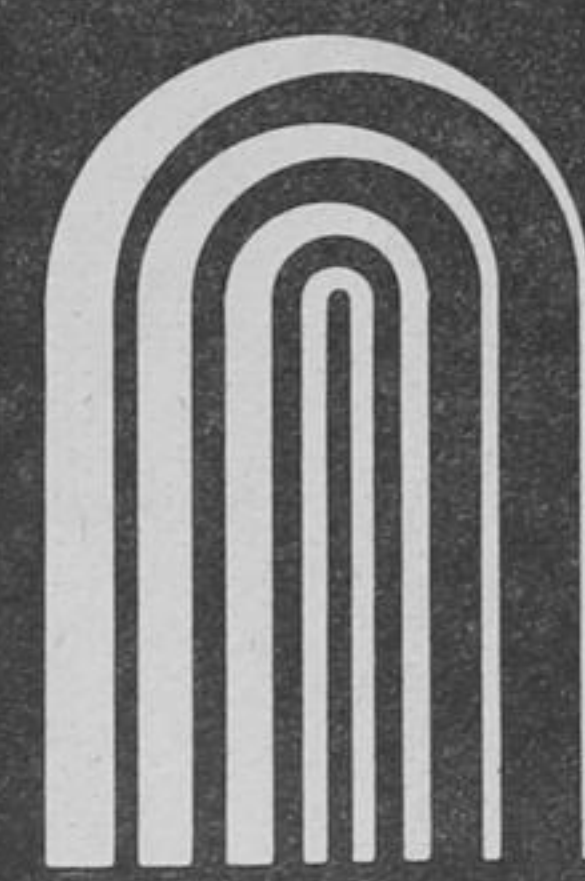
