One of the attractions of the Markham Heritage Festival last Saturday at the Markham Museum was the antique steam engine owned and operated by Ronald Haines.

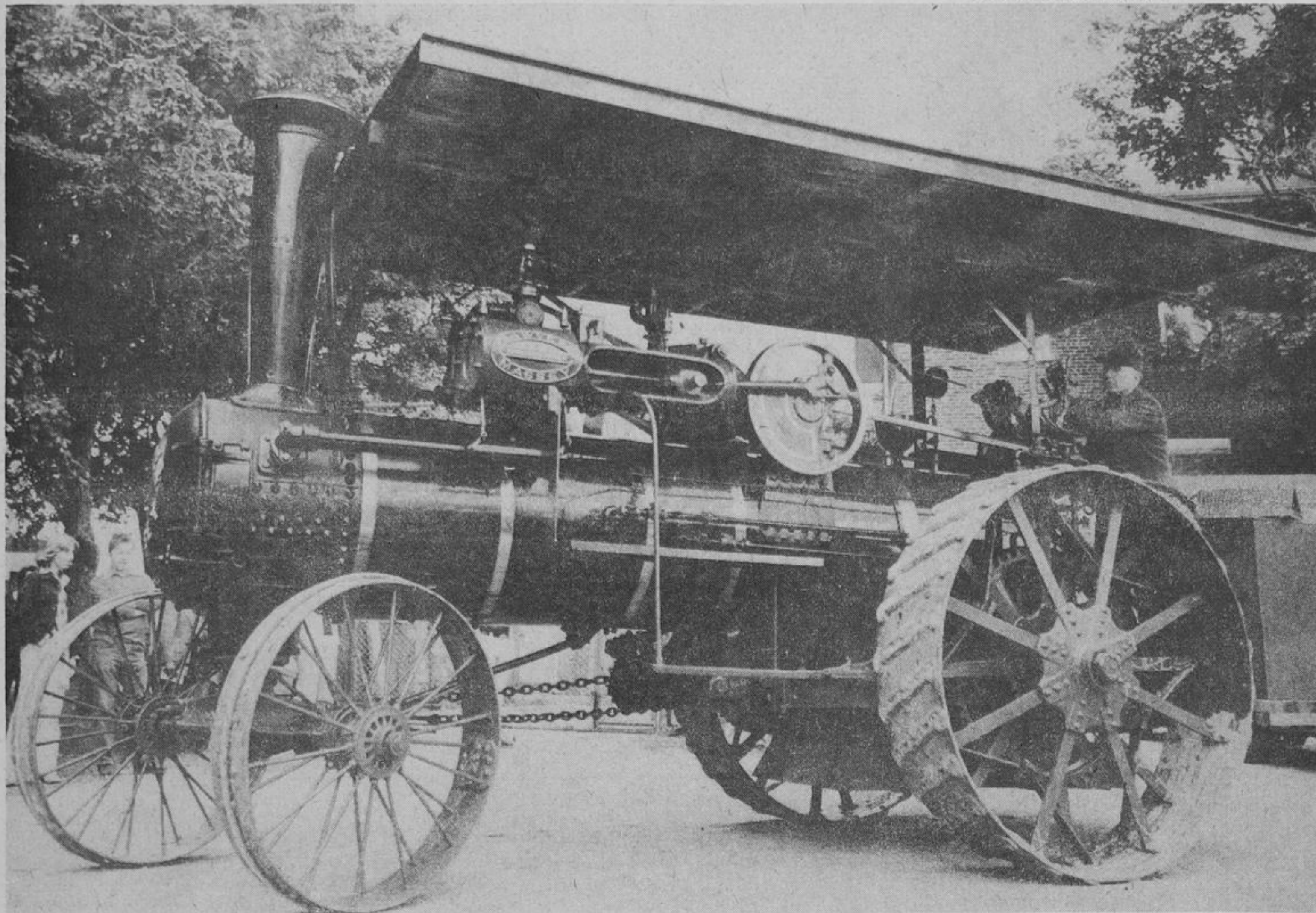
Steam engines, courtesy of the Georgian Bay Steam Association, will be an attraction again this weekend at the
