A citadel is defined as a fortress with high walls usually built on a hill or mountain. "La Citadelle", at Cap Haitien in Haiti, got its name because it conforms so magnificently to this definition. Built in the early 1800s by King Henri Christophe it rises 3,000 feet above sea level. Many people hve compared it to the pyramids in

awesomeness. The construction of this monstrous building took 13 years of back-breaking labor by over two hundred thousand Haitians. Everything that went into it-bricks, wood, stone, gravel, etc. had to be hauled up the mountain. Three hundred cannons were brought up there with each taking fif-

Citadelle" was planned as a fortress city complete with food, supplies, and ammunition where fifteen thousand people could hold out for years! King Christophe built it as a defense against the French, who he thought would return after a previous defeat. However the fortress was never attacked. "La Citadelle" is one

of the top attractions of the Caribbean. It's well worth the somewhat lengthy trip up the mountain to see what some have called the eighth wonder of the world.


