## York Regional Police Briefs

Acts of violence sparked several incidents, leading to arrests, in the Region.

In one of them, a Toronto taxi driver was grabbed by the neck by one of his fares, as he made his way along Jane Street, near Steeles, and was threatened with a knife.

He told police he was robbed, placed on the floor in the rear of the cab and then dumped out north of Jane Street. His passengers drove off in his cab.

BERSERK

Police reported two men allegedly going "berserk" in separate incidents.

In the first one, police said that a man, who was arrested for impaired driving, attacked the interior of the police car with a metal splint on his right hand, en route to the police station. His actions resulted in some broken windows.

He later refused a second breathalyzer test and then broke away, while at York Central Hospital. Facing charges of impaired driving, refusing a breath sample and escaping lawful custody, is Robert McNamara, 20, of Laverock Avenue, Richmond Hill.

GIRLS ATTACKED

A few hours later, police said a man attacked three girls at a King City residence, allegedly trying to strangle one, stepping on the head of another and throwing around a third. He then left the house, only to return with a pellet gun and fire several shots.

No one was hit. Facing three charge of common assault and two of dangerous use of a firearm, is Albert Doiron, 19, of Markham.

PUMP DAMAGED

In Richmond Hill, police arrested Lyle Secord, 29, of King City, as a result of an incident at Pat's Texaco self-serve station on Yonge Street. Police said that a man smashed the glass in a

gas pump, after being told to turn off his engine, in order to get his gas tank filled.

Secord is to be charged with causing mischief to private property over \$50.

HOUSE WRECKED

Unknown damage was done to a house at the corner of Lee Avenue and Noble Street in Milliken, by vandals, who punched holes in the walls, scattered items about, left the taps running in the sinks and broke furniture and win-






