York Regional Council, which has often been accused of sitting on the fence, did its best last week to see that there wasn't going to be one there to begin with.

school sites. Council approved a

subdivision plan in the Town of Markham, but refused to be fenced in by a proposal from York County Board of Education that required the developer to build a nine-strand page-wire fence with gates on the street frontage on all sides of the school site.

The fence was to be "maintained in good condition" throughout construction and then be replaced by a permanent chain link fence, six feet

Newmarket Mayor Bob Forhan led the fight. "If the board wants to build a fence, let them do it," he said.

The school site was board property and it wasn't the region's responsibility to negotiate for the fence.
