Window marks happy life

As a legacy from a family that enjoyed life in Maple, a stained glass window was dedicated at St. Stephen's Anglican Church recently. The children of the late Margaret and George Sanderson presented the window "to recall a happy family and community life shared in Maple from 1945 to 1975". Mr. Sanderson was a well-known Toronto lawyer. The work of craftsman Stephen Taylor, the window is known as a "Unity Rose" design, with a large ruby circle in the centre. The other colors incorporated in the window; purple, blue and green have the richness associated with early medieval stained glass. The memorial service was conducted by the Right Rev. Frederick Wilkinson, a former Bishop of Toronto.
