

Little takes top society honors

With a total of 186 points, Robert Little led the 24 specimen exhibitors in the 1977 flower shows held by the Richmond Hill Horticultural Society, it was announced at the society's recent Christmas party.

He also won two points for arrangements and had two specimens in the court of honor during the season.

Runner-up in the specimen category was William Barker with 148 points. He also had a court of honor in specimens and one in vegetables as well as three points in arrangements and 50 in vegetables.

William Risebrough, with 129 points, was third in the specimen classes, had one court of honor and three points in vegetables.

He also won the Richmond Hill Horticultural Society Rose Bowl for the highest aggregate points in roses, the Red Rose Tea trophy for the best red rose in the June show and the Freeman Barker

Memorial Award for the best back garden belonging to a member of the society.

His wife, Jean, received a certificate of service from the local society, to make it a real Risebrough night.

Edna Beattie had been honored by the society with a similar certificate earlier in the year.

Jack Manning earned 99 points in specimens, one court of honor, and eight points in arrangements. Velma Shelletto had 57 points in specimens and two in arrangements. Margaret Styan added together 53 specimen points, 22 arrangement points and two vegetable points.

Otto Connor earned 42 points for his specimen entries, a court of honor and 17 points for his vegetables.

Margaret Woods' record included 42 points for specimens, one court of honor and four arrangement points.

Mr. and Mrs. George Crisp had 33 points for specimens and 14 for arrangements. Vivian

Hart earned 26 points for specimens and 36 for arrangements.

Mrs. George Barker led the 19 exhibitors in the arrangement classes with 88 points and had five court of honor awards during the year. She also won the coveted Royal Bank of Canada trophy. Other court of honor

awards went to Joyce Saleuddin, Flavia Redelmeier and Mr. and Mrs. Norman Bell who also won 17 points in vegetables.

The members and their young guests enjoyed being mystified by a magician and partaking of Christmas goodies.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION

BY
THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF VAUGHAN TO DISPENSE WITH A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

- The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Vaughan intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval to construct a works yard complex consisting of a garage, office space, parking lot, gasoline tanks and storage facilities at an estimated cost of \$500,000.00. The sum of \$100,000 was allocated for this purpose out of lot levies received by the Corporation and the balance of \$400,000.00 shall be raised by the sale of debentures, which will be repayable over a term of ten (10) years.
- Application will be made to The Ontario Municipal Board for an order to dispense with the assent of the electors to the undertaking of the said works. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice which is December 14th, 1977, send by post prepaid to the Clerk of the Town of Vaughan, at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval and the grounds of such objection.
- The Ontario Municipal Board may order pursuant to the statute that the assent of the electors shall not be required and may approve of the said works, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered.
