Block parents issue update

By DOREEN LIVINGSTONE The Thornhill Block Parent Central Committee Executive recently issued a block parent update.

The current executive consists of Carol Andrews, Lynda Wadsworth, Kathryn Hall, Helen Strickland, Nancy Hyde, Nancy Shannon and Nan Henderson. Thornhill, one of 85 Block Parent Committees in Ontario, and one of 200 across Canada, boasts 770 Block Parents. In the 18 months since its formation, the Block Parent program is now in all 12 public schools, three separate schools, two new residential areas without schools and has been introduced to the nursery schools.

Most of this year's kindergarten children know all about block parents. The absence check program is now in all area public and separate schools with the exception of Thornhill-Langstaff school.

In addition to speaking to each class K-6 in every school at least once a year, there have been block parent weeks or fun fairs in many schools, involving poster contests, bingo games, block parent mapping contests, films, puzzles and word games, all of which were block parent oriented.

The committee is very

appreciative of the encouragement and assistance of principals and teachers of all area schools as well as by the full co-operation of the York Regional Police and their safety bureau who speak about the block parent program in schools, attend conferences and generally provide advice through their block parent manual. Markham Town Council and Mayor Tony Roman have assisted the group by lending the use of a variety of equipment and facilities.

A number of service clubs and companies including the Thornhill Kiwanis, the Thornhill Recycling Depot, Shell Oil, Gulf Oil and Costain Development have supported the group financially.

Representatives have been sent to conferences in Toronto, London and Collingwood and block parents have manned booths at two Kiwanis craft shows, area libraries, kindergarten registrations and "Meet the Teacher Nights".

They have also participated in the Thornhill Historical Festival Parade.

During block parent week there were displays in three libraries in conjunction with the York Regional Police Safety Bureau and their Safety car "Sparky".

Snowmobile races set at Oak Ridges

The excitement will be contagious, and it will be fun.

The annual snowmobile races are coming to Oak Ridges, only this year, they will be bigger and better than ever.

The races, sponsored by the Oak Ridges and District Minor Hockey Association and Accel, will be held on January 15 and February 12, instead of just one day, as in the past.

The committee, headed by Bill Reddy, started working for these races in the Spring. They arranged for sponsors, permits and a hundred other details.

Bill Mitchell offered the use of his property to the west of Bond Lake Arena, Al Ryman will supply the truck to keep the track watered, Labatts Brewery will supply the sound system, Accel will be providing prizes, and many others will be involved as well.

There will be 14 races per day, including juniors and powder puff.

Races will be held in stock, super stock and modified classes each day.

There will be a prize daily for total points and there will be a trophy for total points over the two days.

Accel, The Performance Line, will give three gate prizes per day, two timing lights and a jacket. A special feature will be

a 75 per cent payback on the races. This means that of all the money paid into each race, 75 per cent will be paid back in prize money.

The races will feature two 10-lap races with a 90 per cent payback. The prize money from these should be worth the effort.

Registration will be held from 10 a.m. to 12:15 the day of the races. Racing will start at 12:30 sharp.

Everyone who wishes to race, must be registered.

Admission prices are: \$2 for adults, 50 cents for children, and a special rate of \$5 for a family.

With the winter weather lately, conditions should be just about perfect for the races.
