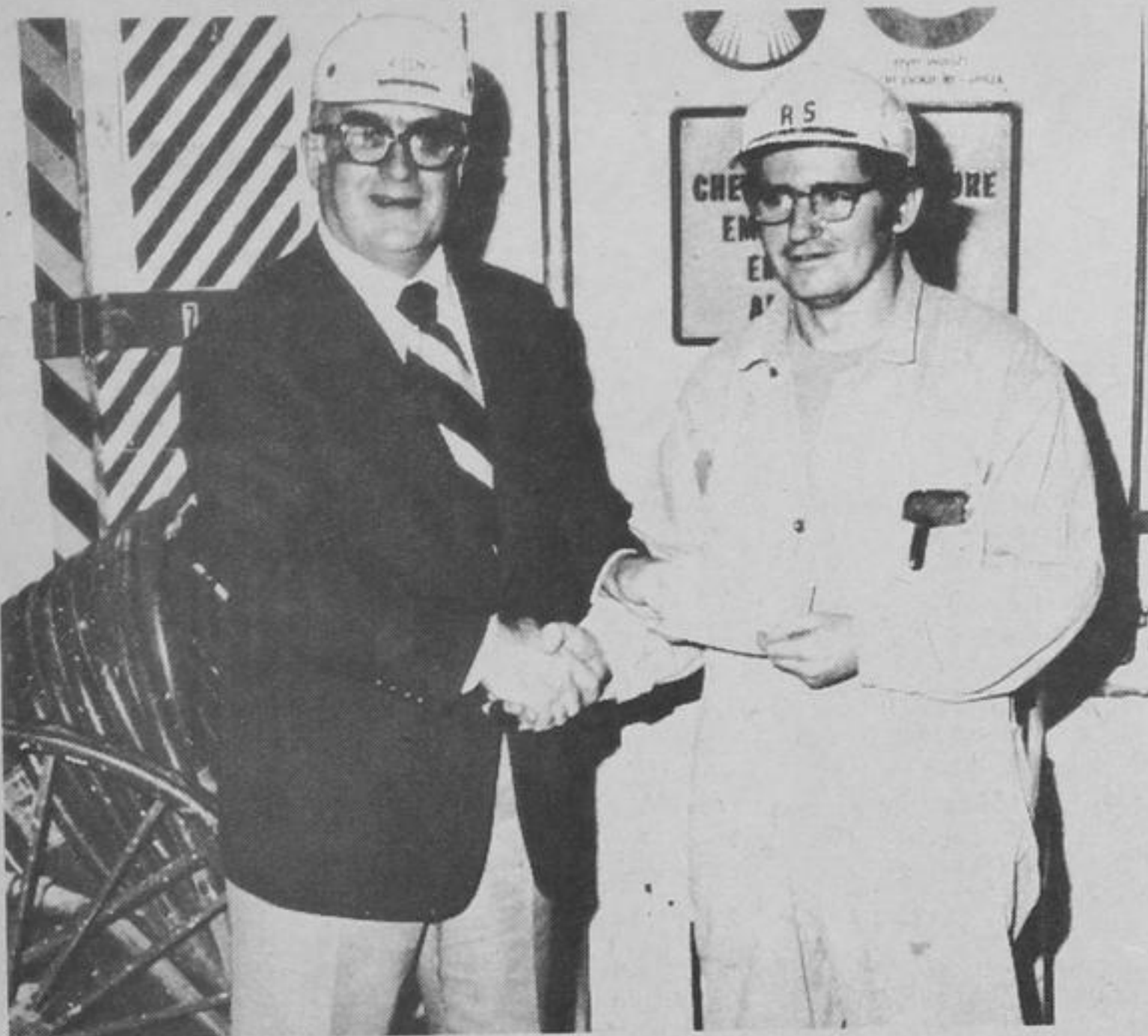

Vaughan plant wins CIL safety prize

The 126 employees of the Canadian Industries Limited Vaughan Centre paint plant have won the top CIL safety prize for the fourth time.

The award represents seven years and 2,220,750 man-hours worked at the Concord plant without a disabling accident.

And, coupled with this, the employees have reduced the frequency of minor injuries and increased their productivity.

Earlier this year, a new record for a single day's production was set, a press release stated.

The Vaughan Centre plant manufactures and packages interior and exterior paint products marketed under CIL and other labels.

Plant safety coordinator and operations planner Rick Royds feels

that the company's investment in larger mixing kettles helped to step up production and reduce risk by "reducing cleanup operations".

In-plant safety training programs are also available to the employees through Jimmy Page, production

supervisor and qualified St. John Ambulance first aid instructor.

Employees also get the chance to learn off-the-job safety through lectures on such topics as safe winter driving techniques, lay treatment of heart attacks and fire department safety tips.
