

# Liberals set recommendations for convention

Major changes are needed in Canada's divorce laws, according to the local provincial Liberal riding association.

Among other recommendations, the York North Liberals also believe Canada's system of government needs a wholesale review — from top to bottom.

The association passed a series of far-reaching resolutions at its recent policy workshop. The recommendations will be sent to the Liberals' national headquarters for consideration in planning the agenda of the party's national policy convention in February.

Divorce should be made

simpler and more equitable, according to three resolutions passed by the association.

The local Liberals suggest that uncontested divorces be granted after one year's separation. The current waiting period is three years.

They also suggest that when no children are involved in an un-

contested divorce, "an administrative process be developed which bypasses the involvement of the courts and allows for dignified and less expensive dissolution of marriages."

The federal government also should develop legislation to promote "equitable concepts and

practices" concerning the division of property in divorces.

That resolution notes that property division laws vary from province to province, "causing uncertainty about how best to arrange a marital relationship" and confusion over legal claims of each partner in the event of a divorce.

All levels of government in Canada need a shake-down, the York North Liberals suggest.

Since Canada "is fighting for its survival" as a united nation, the federal government should launch a "fundamental review of our constitution, our institutions and their roles, from the Monarch to the

structure of the federal, provincial and municipal governments in order to obtain new consensus from the people of Canada."

"Sexual orientation" should be a right protected by the constitution, the Liberals say.

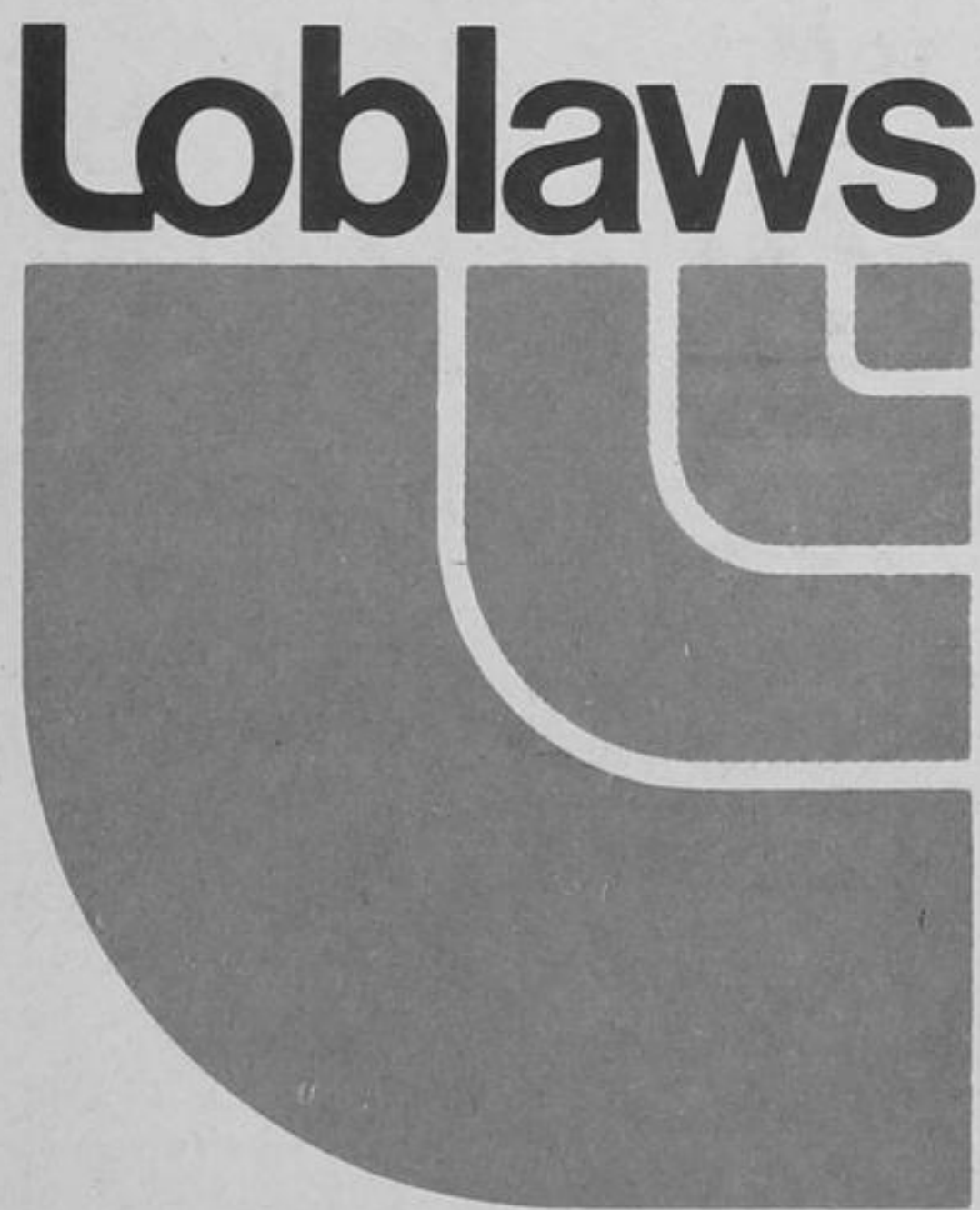
All persons should be legally "protected

against discrimination on the basis of race, national or ethnic origin, color, religion, age, sex, language, physical handicap, marital status or sexual orientation," the resolution urges.

To combat labor strife, the York North Liberals suggest "a form of

voluntary binding arbitration" be included in contracts involving unionized federal employees.

Such collective agreements also should force each party to accept the findings of arbitrators for a "cooling-off" period of at least a year, according to the resolution.
