**Former Carrville area man dies in hospital**

Robert Edwin Middleton, also known as Bert and Rusty, a respected citizen of the Carrville area for more than 40 years, died at Palmerston District Hospital recently.

He was in his 76th year. Services were held at Carrville United Church in Vaughan, with burial in Carrville Cemetery.

Mr. Middleton was born in Thistleton and moved to the Carrville area as a teenager where his parents owned the Read farm on Bathurst Street, and later built the Kirk home on Carrville Sideroad.

As a young man he began to teach Sunday School in Carrville United Church and was superintendent there for 40 years.

He was also an elder of the church.

Mr. Middleton was also associated with the old Richmond Hill Combines Lacrosse team.

He was married to Murel Walker in April, 1933, and they lived on the Carrville Sideroad until 1967 when they moved to Palmerston.

Mr. Middleton worked at Canada Wire and Cable in Leaside for 25 years and was a member of their Quarter Century Club.

He was predeceased by his wife on October 5, 1977.

He is survived by his daughters, Marion (Mrs. Jas. Ash) of Moorefield; Gretta (Mrs. William Gill) of Collingwood; Nancy (Mrs. Harold Ellis) of Moorefield; and son, Robert, of Port Credit.
