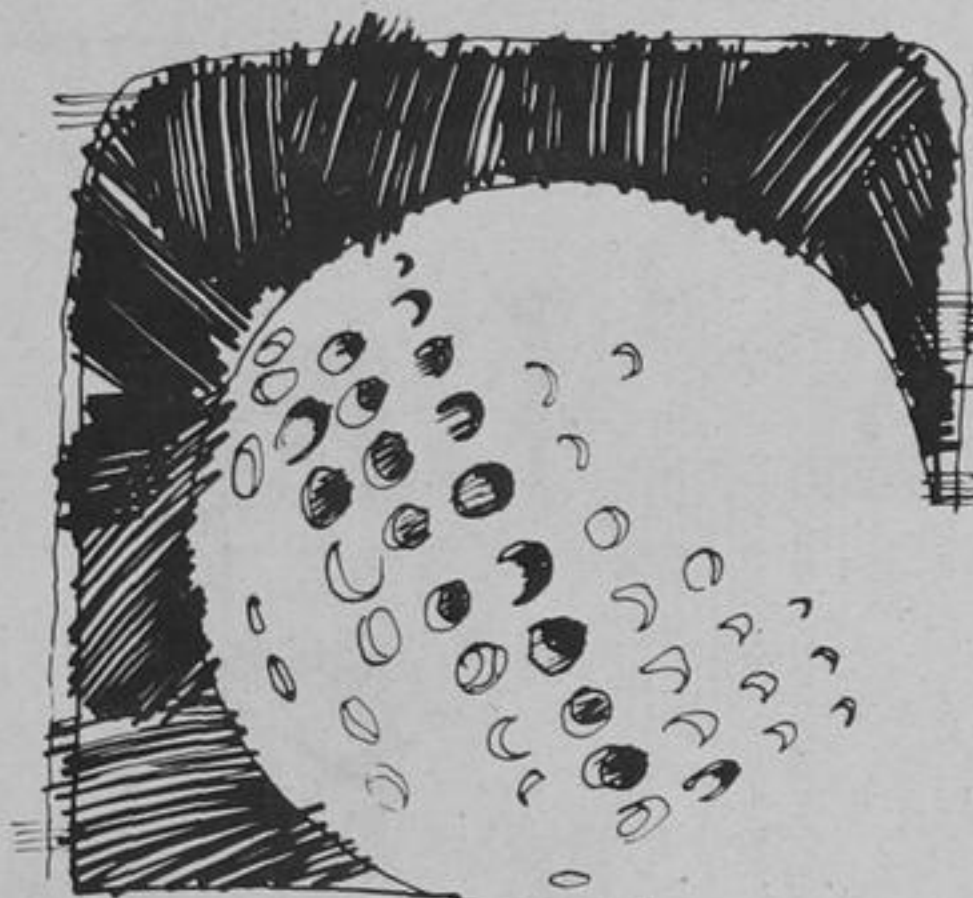

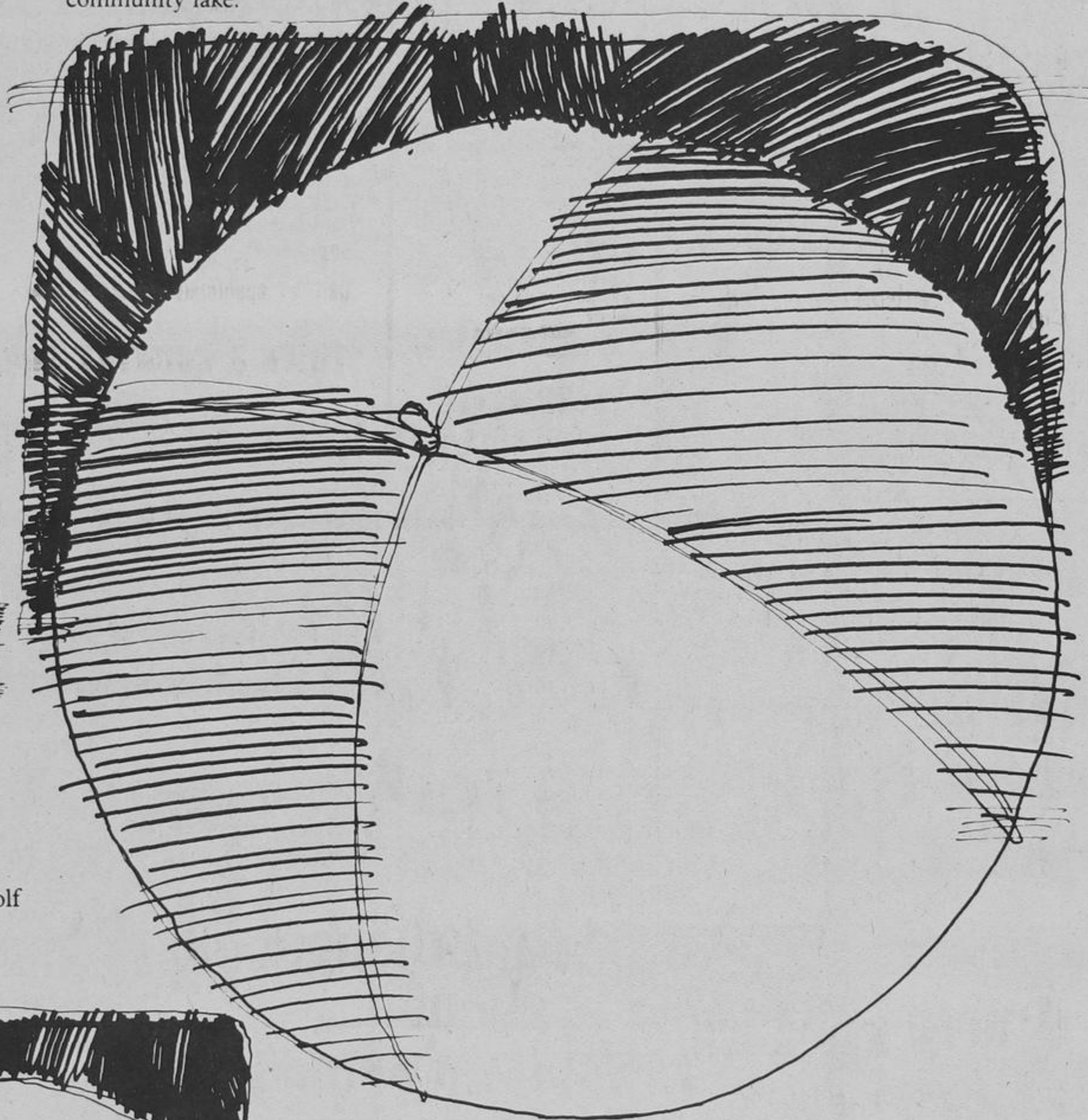


Anyone for tennis? You'll be a match for anyone on your own community courts in Willow Lane.

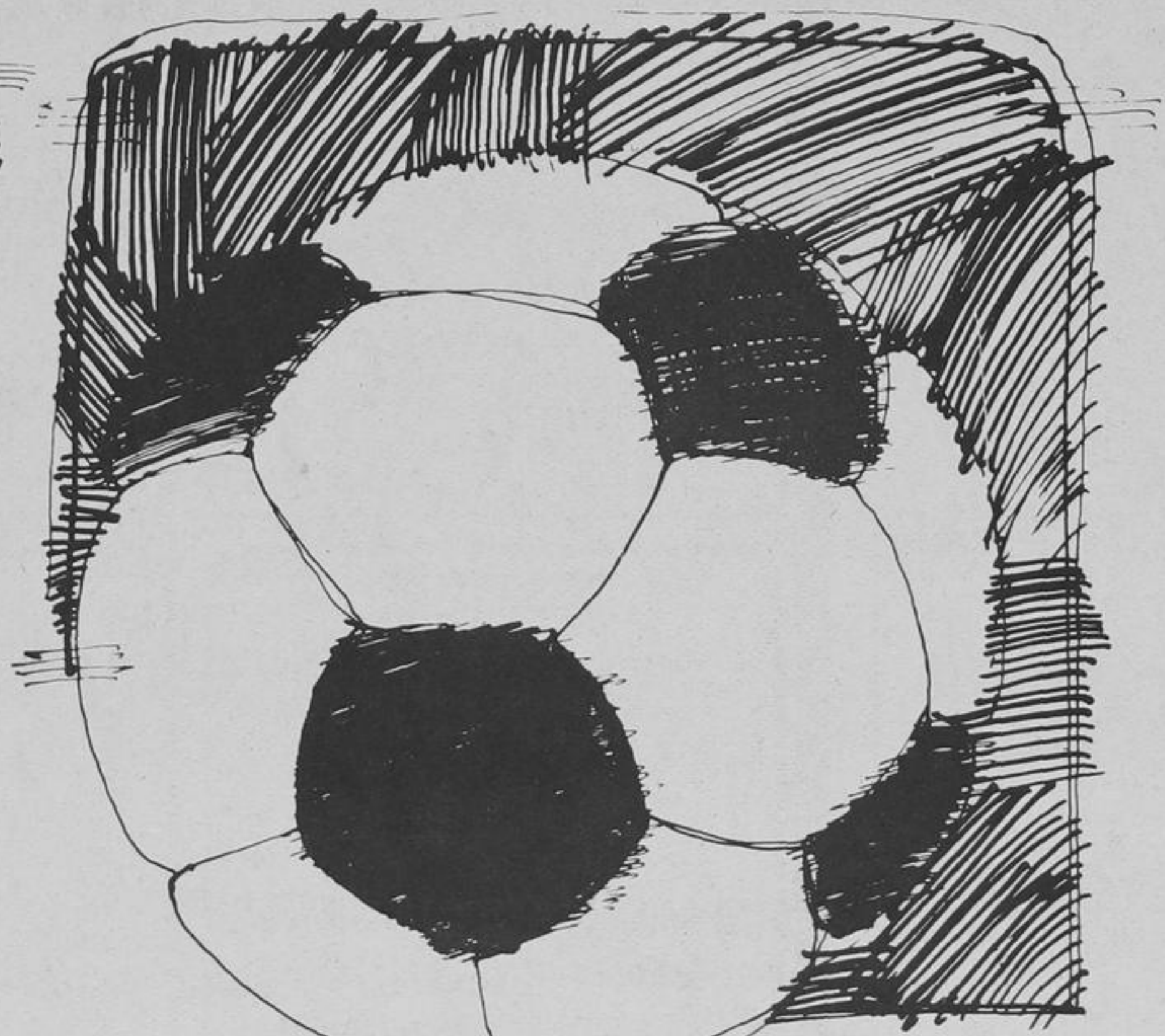


You'll have a swinging time playing golf on the two superb courses just a short drive away.

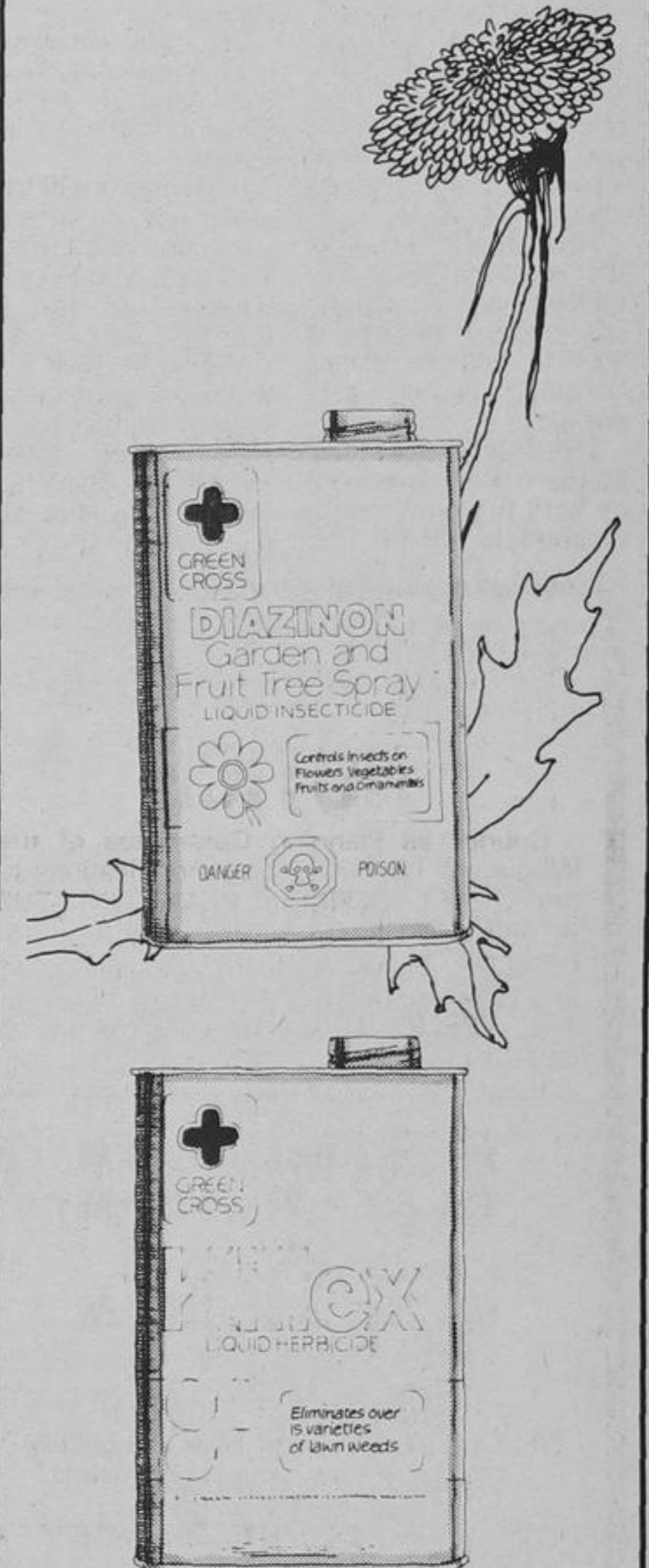
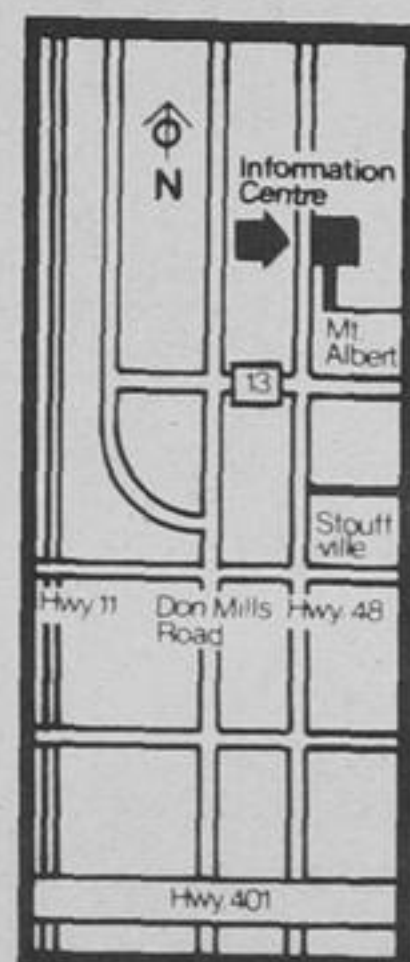
