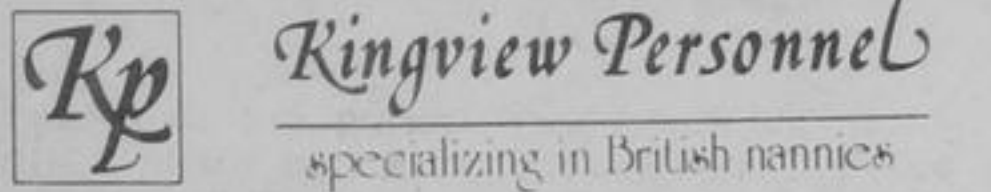

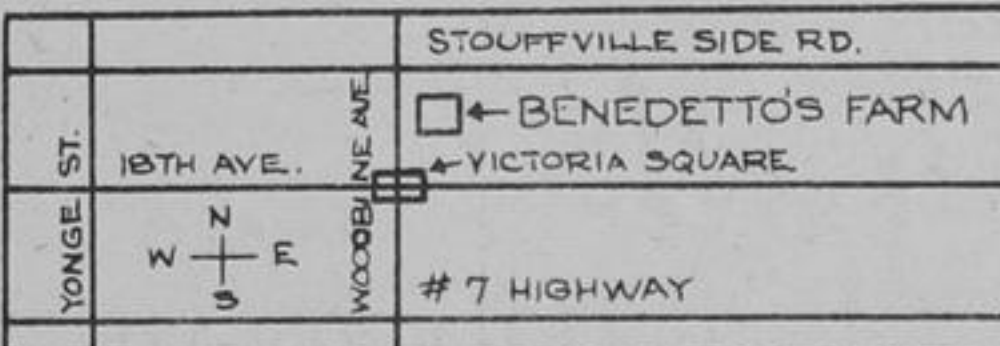

**A SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING RE THE MODIFICATIONS TO THE (NEW) OFFICIAL PLAN**

A Special Meeting of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham will be held in the Council Chambers on Tuesday, June 27, 1978 at 4:00 P.M. to consider certain modifications to the (New) Official Plan of the Markham Planning Area.

The (New) Official Plan of the Markham Planning Area was adopted by Council on September 22, 1976 and was submitted to the Honourable Minister of Housing for approval.

The modifications to be discussed at the meeting have been suggested by the Honourable Minister, or have arisen out of further submissions on and consideration of the (New) Official Plan by Council.

The major modifications to be proposed by Council will include the following:

- changes in staging policy to provide for a flexible approach to development after the opening of York-Durham Trunk Sewer.
- changes to the Secondary Plan approval process.
- designation of a study area in Concession IV between the Parkway Bet West and 16th Avenue.
- changes in land use designations
  - (i) Risebrough - relocation of the Industrial Area to follow the CNR tracks.
  - (ii) Leslie East - change from residential to industrial of the "Bishop's Cross" lands.
  - (iii) Markham Old Town - change from industrial to residential of the Captain lands.
  - (iv) Lands at the South West Corner of 7th Line and 16th Avenue - change from residential and hazard lands to open space of the Toronto General Burying Grounds' lands.

Areas of the Plan which are in dispute, and which are being referred to the Ontario Municipal Board, will not be considered at this time.

The proposed modifications may be inspected in the office of the Planning Department after June 21st, 1978.

All interested persons are invited to attend the meeting and to state their views.

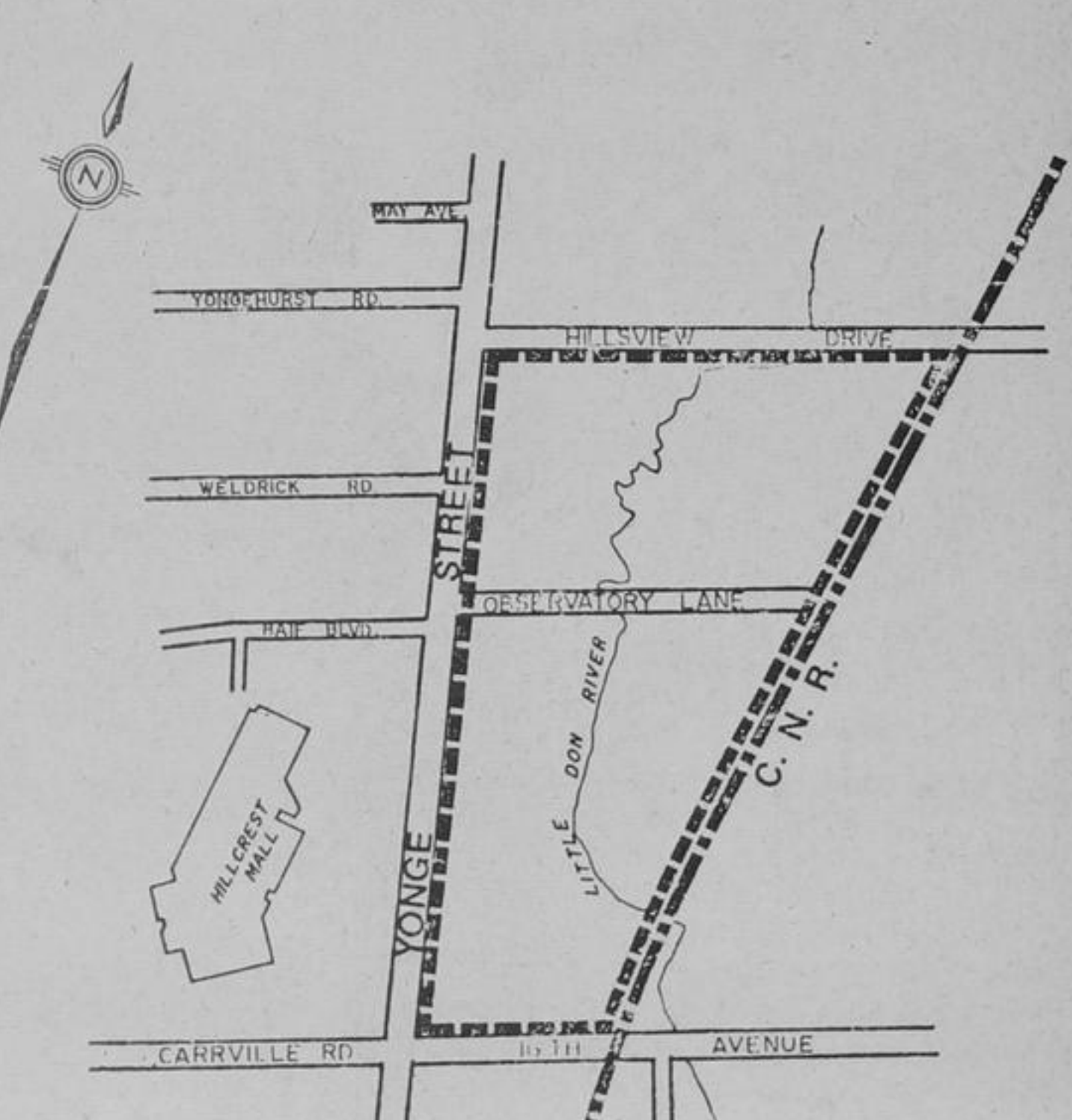
